**DETAILS:**

The following supplemental report is regarding an officer involved shooting incident that occurred on August 16, 2020 at 516 North San Jacinto in the city of Hemet. The suspect, later identified as Ysidro Espinoza, was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Detective Wood was charted on August 16, 2020 by Riverside County District Attorney Senior Investigator Villalobos and Menifee Police Department Forensic Tech Keene. The charting consisted of digital photographs of Detective Wood and documentation of Detective Wood's uniform, equipment and service weapon. Sr. Investigator Villalobos charted Detective Wood's service weapon; a Glock 17, serial number BFLK158, 9mm Semi-automatic handgun with a Streamlight TLR-1 HL tactical light. Detective Wood did not fire his weapon during the incident.

Detective Wood, from the Hemet Police Department, was identified as arriving on scene as the officer involved shooting was occurring.

On August 19, 2020, at approximately 1624 hours, Detective Wood agreed to meet me with me and provide a voluntary statement. The interview was conducted in a conference room at the Hemet Police Department. Detective Klinzing of the Hemet Police Department and Brandy Harper of Law Firm of Castillo Harper were also present during the interview. Per Hemet Police Department policy, officers can provide an uninterrupted statement prior to viewing video recordings of the incident. Detective Wood chose to waive the uninterrupted statement and viewed his video recording prior to providing a statement.

**SUMMARY OF DETECTIVE WOOD'S INTERVIEW ON AUGUST 19, 2020:**

Detective Wood provided a voluntary statement as to his involvement in the Officer Involved Shooting incident. The following is a synopsis of the interview with Detective Wood. The statements may not be in the order in which they were provided, this was done to clarify the report as much as possible. Detective Wood arrived on scene as the officer involved shooting occurred. Because Detective Wood was not present at the time of the shooting, his statement was not submitted for transcription.

Detective Wood was with his partner Detective Willison were involved in the homicide investigation that occurred the night before. Detective Wood stated Officer Schroeder broadcasted a license plate, which Detective Wood recognized as belonging the suspect. Shortly after broadcasting the plate, Officer Schroeder requested additional units and stated he was in pursuit of the suspect. Detective Wood and Detective Willison were close by and they proceeded to assist in the pursuit.

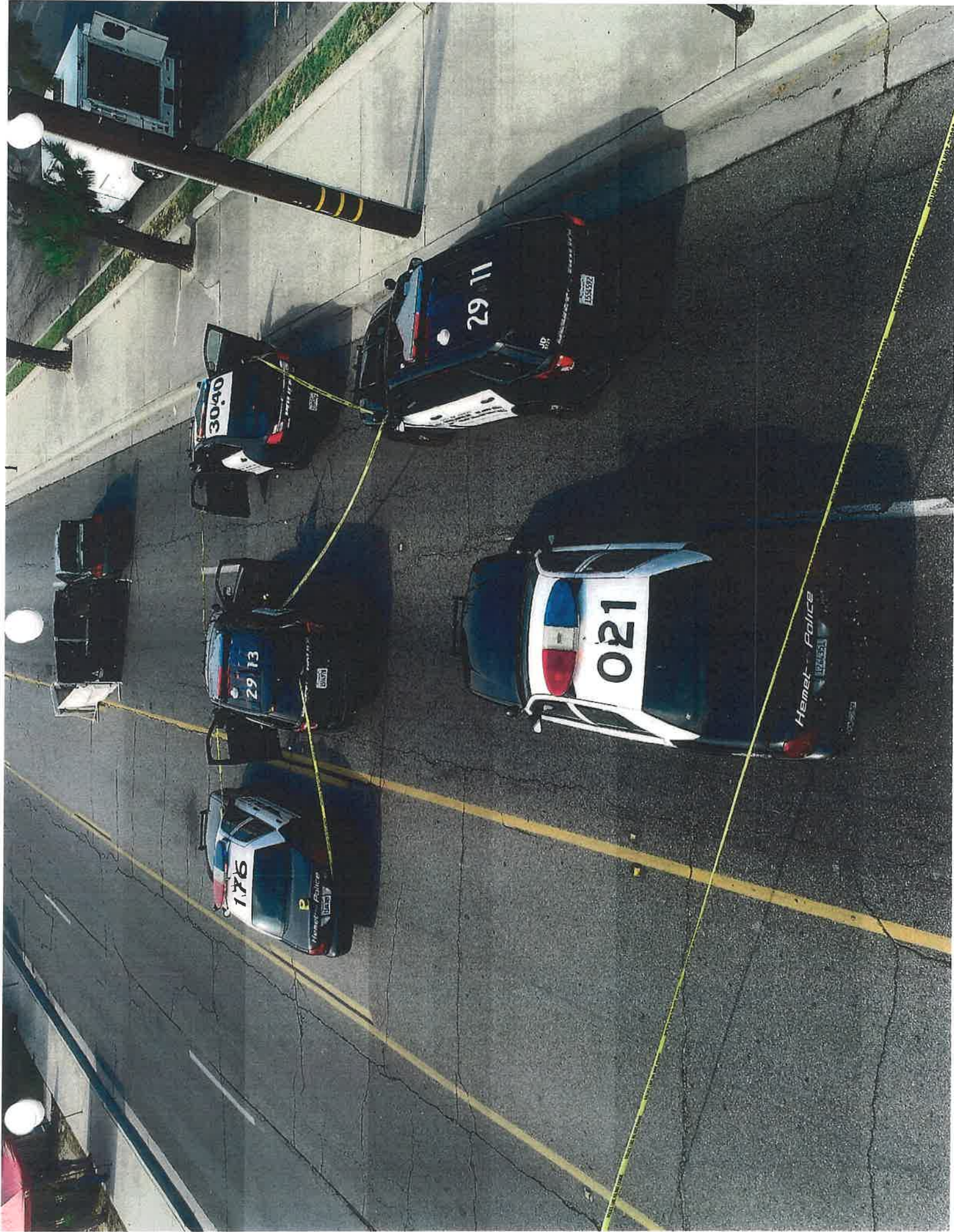
Detective Wood and Detective Willison trailed the pursuit and ensured no civilian vehicles entered in the pursuit. They trailed the pursuit during the duration of the pursuit. As Detective Wood was driving and he stopped his vehicle behind the patrol vehicles at the termination of the pursuit. As Detective Wood was exiting his vehicle, he was able to see the suspect exit his own car. Detective Wood was able to see the suspect had a gun pointed at his own head. Detective Wood then heard gun shots and the suspect fell to the ground. Detective Wood stated it was within a second of the suspect getting out of the car with the gun pointed at his head that he heard the gun shots and saw the suspect fall to the ground. Detective Wood was part of the take down team that approached the suspect.

Detective Wood stated, prior to the homicide investigation, he had not had any encounters with the suspect in the past. During the interview, I presented Detective Wood a picture of the scene of the deputy involved shooting to refresh his recollection of the scene.


