Report Preparation

- (a) Sudden or accidental deaths.
- (b) Suicides.
- (c) Homicide or suspected homicide.
- (d) Unattended deaths (No physician or qualified hospice care in the 20 days preceding death).
- (e) Found dead bodies or body parts.

323.2.4 INJURY OR DAMAGE BY CITY PERSONNEL

Reports shall be taken if an injury occurs that is a result of an act of a City employee. Additionally, reports shall be taken involving damage to City property or City equipment.

323.2.5 MISCELLANEOUS INJURIES

Any injury that is reported to this department shall require a report when:

- (a) The injury is a result of drug overdose
- (b) Attempted suicide
- (c) The injury is major/serious, whereas death could result
- (d) The circumstances surrounding the incident are suspicious in nature and it is desirable to record the event

The above reporting requirements are not intended to be all-inclusive. A supervisor may direct an employee to document any incident he/she deems necessary.

323.2.6 MANDATORY REPORTING OF JUVENILE GUNSHOT INJURIES

A report shall be taken when any incident in which a child 18 years or younger suffered an unintentional or self-inflicted gunshot wound. The Records Bureau shall notify the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) of the incident as required by CDPH (Penal Code § 23685).

323.3 GENERAL POLICY OF EXPEDITIOUS REPORTING

In general, all officers and supervisors shall act with promptness and efficiency in the preparation and processing of all reports. An incomplete report, unorganized reports or reports delayed without supervisory approval are not acceptable. Reports that are not completed within the allotted time frame are late reports, and the employee failing to complete the report will be subject to discipline. Officers and supervisors will have four (4) working days to turn in any and all reports, to include misdemeanors, felonies, general, DUI and accident reports. Any "in-custody" report will be completed the day it is taken. Only with the on-duty watch commanders approval, may an in-custody report be held more than one day. Reports shall be processed according to established priorities or according to special priority necessary under exceptional circumstances.

SUBJECT: NOTICE TO SUBJECT OF ADMINISTRATIVE INVESTIGATION

The City of Dinuba is conducting an administrative investigation regarding your involvement in the events that occurred on July 7, 2019 in connection with the arrest and detainment of the incorrect suspect after a pursuit (Case#DF1902030). I have assigned Lieutenant Iriarte to conduct this Administrative Investigation, and he will contact you to obtain your taped statement regarding this incident. He will provide you the location, date, and time for your interview, and you are ordered to report in accordance with Lieutenant Iriarte's instruction. Failure to appear will be considered an act of insubordination and can be an independent basis for disciplinary action.

You will be compensated for your time in accordance with regular department procedures. Your interview will cover all aspects of your involvement in the vehicle pursuit, the search for the suspect who fled, and the arrest, detainment, and release of the incorrect suspect. The interview will also cover the reason(s) for and scope of the search of the incorrect suspect's residence, the adequacy of the investigation, interviews of and decisions not to interview witnesses involved in or suspected to be involved in the incident, the accuracy of the reports written about the incident and arrest of the incorrect suspect, and the release and treatment of the incorrect suspect.

Failure to appear for your scheduled interview will be considered an act of insubordination and can be an independent basis for disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal.

You are hereby ordered to cooperate fully with Lt. Iriarte and answer his questions in a complete and truthful manner. You are further ordered to obey any lawful order given by Lt. Iriarte.

The interview will be recorded. You will have access to the recording if any further proceedings are contemplated or prior to any further investigative interview at a subsequent time. You have the right to bring your own recording device and record any and all aspects of the investigative interview.

You have the right to bring a representative of your choice who may be present at all times during the investigative interview. However, the representative you choose cannot be someone who is subject to the same investigation. Your representative shall not be required to disclose, nor be subject to any punitive action for refusing to disclose, any information received from you while under investigation in non-criminal matters. You must provide me with one (1) working days' notice if you will be represented by legal counsel as the City may then also choose to have counsel present.

While this administrative investigation is pending and in order to ensure a full, fair and effective investigation in this matter and to preserve public confidence in the City's ability to operate effectively, you are urged not to discuss this notice, the allegations, the administrative investigation, or any of the administrative interviews, including your own, with anyone other than Lt. Iriarte, your union representatives and/or legal counsel. This is not intended to prevent you from engaging in protected concerted activity under the Meyer-Milias Brown Act. You may continue to engage in protected concerted activity under the Act, including but not limited to discussing any other aspects of your employment and working conditions with others, including co-workers. If you are unsure whether discussing certain issues with others would violate this order, you are encouraged to consult with your union representatives and/or legal counsel, who may advise you.

City of Dinuba employees are prohibited from engaging in retaliation. You shall not retaliate against any individual who you know or may reasonably anticipate will be a witness in this investigation, nor shall you attempt to influence any witness to this matter.

Failure to comply fully with the provisions of this notice may result in discipline. If you have any questions regarding this notice or the investigation, please contact Lieutenant Abel Iriarte at (559) 591-5914 ext. 226.

The interview will also cover the reason(s) for and scope of the search of the incorrect suspect's residence, your conversations with witnesses involved in or suspected to be involved in the incident, the information from witnesses you conveyed or did not convey to superiors, the accuracy of the reports written about the incident, your decision not to write a report, and the arrest of the incorrect suspect.

Failure to appear for your scheduled interview will be considered an act of insubordination and can be an independent basis for disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal.

Lieutenant Abel Iriarte is conducting the investigation and will conduct your interview. You are hereby ordered to cooperate fully with Lt. Iriarte and answer his questions in a complete and truthful manner. You are further ordered to obey any lawful order given by Lt. Iriarte.

The interview will be recorded. You will have access to the recording if any further proceedings are contemplated or prior to any further investigative interview at a subsequent time. You have

the right to bring your own recording device and record any and all aspects of the investigative interview.

You have the right to bring a representative of your choice who may be present at all times during the investigative interview. 

Sunday, July 7, 2019 at about 3am I was arrested for a crime I did not commit even after I kept telling the responding officers that I had been with my girlfriend since Saturday night to early Sunday morning a bit before I got arrested. My dad, mom, three sisters and two of my cousins were told they needed to get out of the house as officers went into our home with a K9 and searched our home. They had no warrant and did not state the reason they were forcing entry into our home. I remember hearing my mother ask what was going on and one of the officers told her to "he's a big boy he can tell you himself". However I was cuffed and put in the police car unable to communicate with my mother or father.

Saturday July, 6, 2019 I walked over to my girlfriends' house [REDACTED] on Magnolia ave at a bit after 10pm. As we were together I got ahold of one of my friends [REDACTED] so he can loan me some money. He was at another friends house. So I asked my girlfriend if she can take me to pick up the \$20 dollars he was lending me. She did. We then stopped at Liquor Locker and I bought some snacks for my sisters and cousins that had stayed home but had previously asked me to buy them some snacks. After dropping off the snacks at around 11pm we went back to [REDACTED] place down Magnolia. Then at about 1:30am (Sunday morning) she drove me back to my place and we stayed in her car talking. Then at about 3am, we noticed several cops were coming down Parkway street and into Gloria avenue. One officer was parked facing North on Gloria avenue with his bright light on. While another officer parked in the middle of Echo street and Gloria avenue as he was moving his bright light back and forth to face both Gloria and Echo street. When the officer that was parked between Gloria and Echo street left down toward Crawford, me and my girlfriend stepped out to the car. However, the officer between Parkway and Gloria still had his bright light on facing North towards my house. I am sure he seen us standing outside in front of her car. My girlfriend decided to go home at about 2:30am Sunday (July 7) morning. I came inside my home and got my clothes ready to jump in the shower. As I was getting ready to jump in the shower, my girlfriend [REDACTED] called me to tell me that she got pulled over down Echo going into Crawford. My girlfriend also told me the officer made her open up the trunk of the car. She asked why and the officer told her they were just looking for someone who had hit a pedestrian and left the scene. [REDACTED] told me that the officer then let her go. I then jumped in the shower. Then I heard banging on the front door, my cousins and my sisters got scared because whoever was pounding on the door did not say anything. They thought it was an intruder. My sister [REDACTED] came to the bathroom door and told me someone was banging on the door and she was scared to open the door. I got out of the shower and quickly put some clothes on and went to open the door as I had water running down my body. When I opened the door, officers were hesitant as they had their hands on their weapon. They were not pointing the guns at me, but they were ready to pull out if needed. An officer asked "is it him?" they paused for a second and another officer said, yeah it's him. I asked what was going on and the officer replied asking "why are you sweating" I responded "I just got out of the shower, what is going on"? Right then the told me to turn around and put my hands on the back of my head. One officer walked me and put me inside the back seat of a police car. Then I seen them proceed going inside the home with a K-9. I remember hearing my mom ask an officer "do you have a warrant"? The officer responded, "we don't need a warrant on a fresh case". Then an officer drove me to the Dinuba police department to interrogate me.



18. **Supervisor's Narrative of Pursuit:** On 07/07/19 at approx. 0216 hours, I (Sgt. Ayala) was working as the on-duty watch commander. I heard Officer Clifton advise over the police radio he was attempting to conduct a traffic stop and had a failure to yield, while traveling southbound on Crawford. Officer Clifton advised the vehicle was a 2 door Silver Mitsubishi Eclipse. Officer Clifton stated the vehicle did not stop at the posted stop sign, at the intersection of Crawford and Saginaw and continued southbound. As he was attempting to catch up he activated his emergency lights and siren and initiated a code-3 vehicle pursuit in approximately the 1300 blk of N. Crawford. Officer Clifton advised he observed the driver begin to throw out objects from the vehicle near the 500 block of N. Crawford. Officer Clifton said he observed the Mitsubishi then go through the red light at the intersection of Crawford and El Monte, while continuing southbound. Officer Clifton said the Mitsubishi reached speeds of up to 85 MPH. Officer Clifton stated as they approached the 1500 block of Park Way, the Mitsubishi attempted to make a westbound turn on to Park Way. Office Clifton stated the vehicle was not able to make the turn and slowed down and stopped on the south west curb at Crawford and Park Way.

Additional non-pursuit information: Officer Clifton observed the driver exit the Mitsubishi and provided a description of a Hispanic male adult, wearing a gray shirt, pants and entering into a back yard, while breaking the fence. A perimeter was set and TCSO K-9 responded. A house to house search began and the K-9 picked up the scent. The K-9 led the Officers to [REDACTED] where contact was made with the residence. At the residence, Officers, made contact with [REDACTED] stated her brother [REDACTED] had just arrived home. [REDACTED] came out and was identified by Officer Clifton as the driver of the Eclipse. He was taken into custody without further incident. A CHP 180 form was completed and the Mitsubishi was stored. After further investigation [REDACTED] was released per 849 (B) PC. 9. CHECK THE CATEGORY THAT BEST DESCRIBES THE VEHICLE TYPE - Of the listed categories, check the type that best describes the vehicle.
10. TOTAL TIME YOUR AGENCY WAS INVOLVED IN VEHICLE PURSUIT - The time, in minutes, that your agency was in the primary position for the pursuit.
11. TOTAL DISTANCE YOUR AGENCY WAS INVOLVED IN VEHICLE PURSUIT - Length, in miles, that your agency was in the primary position for the pursuit.
12. COUNTY WHERE YOUR AREA INVOLVEMENT BEGAN - The county your Agency was in when involved in the pursuit.
13. AGENCY INITIATING VEHICLE PURSUIT - Name of the Agency which initiated the pursuit.
14. DID YOUR AGENCY TURN THE PURSUIT OVER? - If your agency turned the vehicle pursuit over to another allied agency, indicate that agency's name and station or office.
15. DID YOUR AGENCY CONCLUDE VEHICLE PURSUIT? - Your agency concluded the pursuit if you did not turn it over to another agency.
16. LIST I.D. NUMBERS OF YOUR AGENCY'S OFFICERS INVOLVED IN VEHICLE PURSUIT - Include only officers actually involved in the vehicle pursuit.
17. HIGHEST NUMBER OF INVOLVED UNITS AT ONE TIME IN YOUR AREA - Enter the highest number of ground enforcement vehicles (including motorcycles and sedans) as well as air units (including helicopters and airplanes) actively involved in the vehicle pursuit at one time.
18. CHECK ONE CONDITION THAT BEST DESCRIBES WEATHER DURING THE PURSUIT - Check the dominant condition for the majority of the pursuit.
19. MAXIMUM SPEEDS ATTAINED - The highest rate of speed attained during the vehicle pursuit on a freeway and/or surface streets. If the suspect did not enter the freeway OR exit to surface streets, enter 0 in the corresponding space.
20. INDICATE ATTEMPTED FORCIBLE STOP(S) AND NUMBER OF TIMES ATTEMPTED - Enter the number of attempts a forcible stop was initiated to terminate the vehicle pursuit. By definition, a forcible stop is the use or presence of a physical force to end a vehicle pursuit (e.g., roadblock, ramming, boxing-in, channelization, pursuit immobilization technique (PIT)).
21. INDICATE NUMBER OF COLLISIONS THAT OCCURRED IN YOUR AREA - Enter the number of collisions for each type (Fatal, Injury, Property Damage Only). If none, enter 0.
22. ORIGINAL VIOLATION OBSERVED BY AGENCY INITIATING THE VEHICLE PURSUIT - Enter the single, most serious violation which led to an enforcement stop on the vehicle and the degree of the violation, i.e., 10851(a) VC and check the felony box.

WERE INJURIES INCURRED AFTER THE VEHICLE PURSUIT? - If any injuries were incurred by peace officers, the suspected driver, passengers in the suspect vehicle, or innocent third parties as a result of any event occurring after the vehicle pursuit (e.g., foot pursuit, arrest, shooting) while your agency was concluding the pursuit, check the "yes" box and indicate the highest degree of injury for each person injured. If the injury was self-inflicted (e.g., the suspect cut their hands while climbing a chain-link fence, self-inflicted gunshot wound), indicate in the self-inflicted field for the respective injury.

- 27. D.O.B. OF PERSON PURSUED - The date of birth of the driver of the suspect vehicle. Use mm/dd/yyyy format.
- 28. GENDER - Indicate whether the driver of the suspect vehicle was male or female.
- 29. DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE? - Check if the driver was under the influence. If yes, indicate alcohol, drugs, or a combination of both.
- 30. ETHNICITY - Indicate the ethnicity that most clearly resembles the driver of the suspect vehicle.
