**DETAILS:**

The following supplemental report is regarding an officer involved shooting incident that occurred on August 16, 2020 at 516 North San Jacinto in the city of Hemet. The suspect, later identified as Ysidro Espinoza, was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Officer Skaug was charted on August 16, 2020 by Riverside County District Attorney Senior Investigator Villalobos and Menifee Police Department Forensic Tech Keene. The charting consisted of digital photographs of Officer Skaug and documentation of Officer Skaug's uniform, equipment and service weapon. Sr. Investigator Villalobos charted Officer Skaug's service weapon; a Glock 21 GEN IV, serial number BETR846, .45 caliber Semi-automatic handgun with a Sure Fire X300 tactical light. Officer Skaug did not fire his weapon during the incident.

On August 19, 2020, at approximately 1358 hours, Officer Skaug agreed to meet me with me and provide a voluntary statement. The interview was conducted in a conference room at the Hemet Police Department.

Detective Klinzing of the Hemet Police Department and Brandy Harper of Law Firm of Castillo Harper were also present during the interview. Per Hemet Police Department policy, officers can provide an uninterrupted statement prior to viewing video recordings of the incident. Officer Skaug chose to waive the uninterrupted statement and viewed video recording prior to providing a statement.

### SUMMARY OF OFFICER SKAUG'S INTERVIEW ON AUGUST 19, 2020:

Officer Skaug provided a voluntary statement as to his involvement in the Officer Involved Shooting incident. The following is a synopsis of the interview with Officer Skaug. The statements may not be in the order in which they were provided, this was done to clarify the report as much as possible. Officer Skaug arrived on scene as the officer involved shooting occurred. Because Officer Skaug was not present at the time of the shooting, his statement was not submitted for transcription.

Officer Skaug was on training at the time of the incident with Officer Featherly. At approximately 0600 hours, Officer Skaug and Officer Featherly were in the station finishing up reports. Officer Skaug stated he heard Officer Schroeder and Officer Maker in a pursuit. Officer Skaug and Officer Featherly left the station to assist in the pursuit.

Officer Skaug and Officer Featherly were not in the pursuit, however they were trailing from a distance. Officer Skaug stated it was confirmed the person in the vehicle was the suspect from the previous night homicide. Officer Skaug stated he heard radio traffic of the suspect reaching in the vehicle during the pursuit. Officer Skaug also remembered hearing the suspect was throwing a white powdery substance out the window during the pursuit.

At the termination of the pursuit, Officer Skaug was in the second vehicle on the west side of all the patrol vehicles. Officer Skaug exited the passenger side of this unit and started running up to the first car in front. As Officer Skaug was approximately next the front tire of his patrol car when he heard the gun shots. Officer Skaug stated he did not see the suspect or his actions.

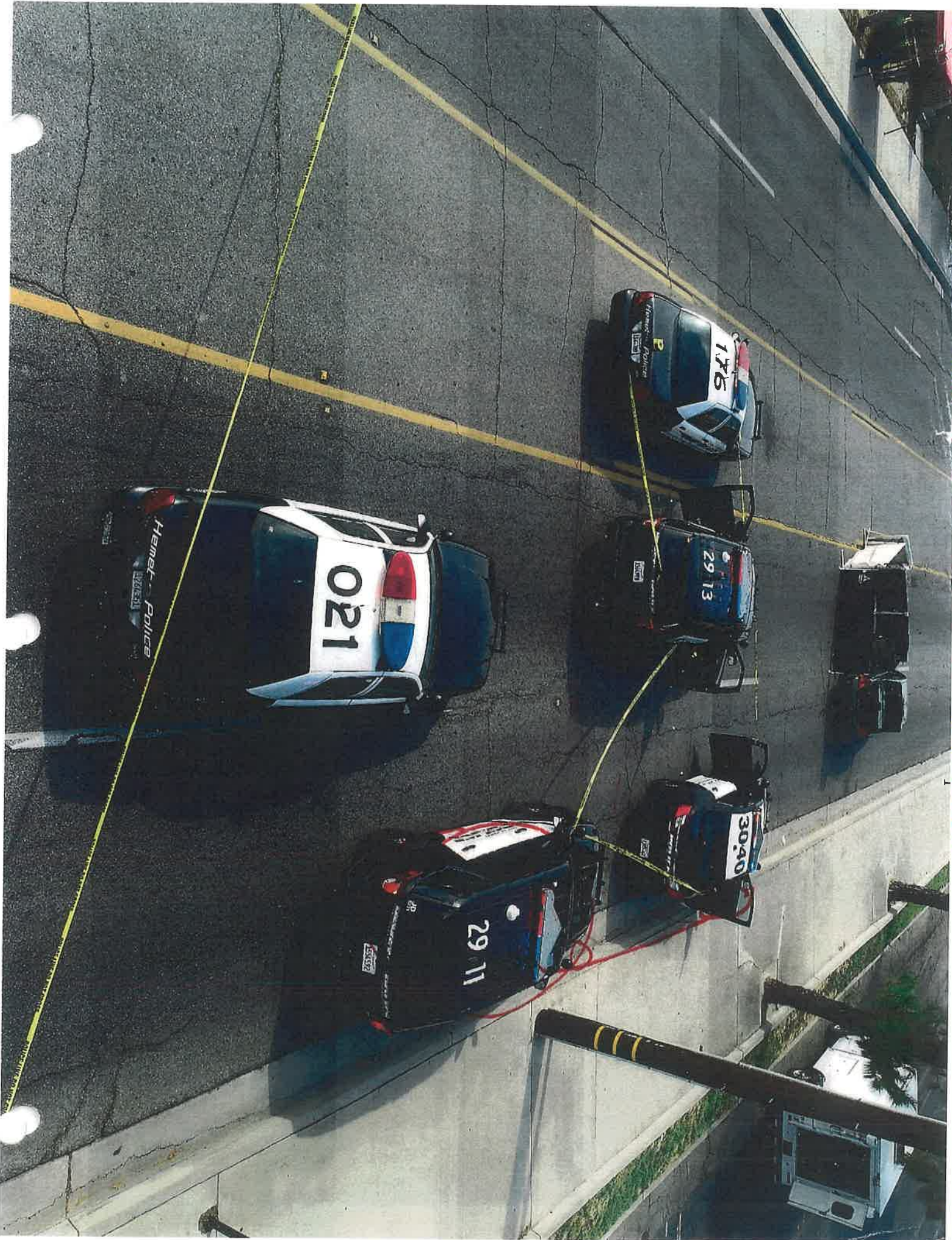
Officer Skaug positioned himself next to Officer Detwiler's vehicle, but he had no visual of the suspect. Officer Skaug heard the two bean bags fired at the suspect. Officer Skaug assisted in the tactical approach of the suspects vehicle. Officer Skaug checked the trunk of the suspects vehicle. Officer Skaug assisted with chest compression on the suspect until he was relieved by paramedics.

Officer Skaug stated he had not had any encounters with Espinoza the past. During the interview, I presented Officer Skaug a picture of the scene of the officer involved shooting to refresh his recollection of the scene.


