Details:

This is a supplemental report to the Officer Involved Shooting incident which occurred at 560 N. San Jacinto Street, Hemet, California on August 16, 2020.

Area Dental Office Surveillance Video:

On Sunday, August 16, 2020, during the crime scene walkthrough I noticed a fixed surveillance camera on the business, Area Dental Office Family Dentistry, located at 560 N. Jacinto Street Hemet, Ca 92543.

On Monday, August 17, 2020, I called Area Dental Office and spoke to Registered Dental Assistant (RDA) Norma Suarez (10/27/91) and inquired about their surveillance video. Suarez said she would consult with Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS) Thanh Truong (4/5/52). I received a return phone call from Suarez and arranged to meet with her and DDS Truong on Wednesday August 19, 2020.

On Wednesday, August 19, 2020, at approximately 0845 hours, I met with RDA Suarez and DDS Truong at Area Dental Office. They said they had surveillance video for Sunday August 16, 2020, however, they did not know how to retrieve the video. They agreed to allow a representative from the Hemet Police Department to retrieve the video. DDS Truong said the cameras were set up to capture the front entrance and the side parking lot and he wasn't sure if there would be a clear view of the street.

On Wednesday, August 19, 2020, at approximately 1300 hours, Intelligence Analyst Anthony Do from the Hemet Police Department met with RDA Suarez and DDS Truong and retrieved the video. Intelligence Analyst Do gave me a DVD with the surveillance video recording. I saved the video to my computer and gave the DVD to Detective Klinzing. When I returned to my office I copied the video file to a DVD and booked it into evidence. The video recording is from 0600 hours to 0707 hours.

The video files consisted of motion sensor video from a camera that was affixed to the dental office above the main entrance, that faces N. San Jacinto Street, and it was labeled ch01. CH01 consisted of eight files [ch01_2020081606 0000; ch01_2020081606 1000; ch01_2020081606 2000; ch01_2020081606 3000; ch01_2020081606 4000; ch01_2020081606 4911; ch01_2020081606 5000 and ch01_2020081607 0230].

There was also video from a camera that was affixed to the dental office along the south side of the building and the file is labeled ch04. CH04 consisted of eight files [ch04_2020081606 0029; ch04_2020081606 1000; ch04_2020081606 2050; ch04_2020081606 3000; ch04_2020081606 4300; ch04_2020081606 4841; ch04_2020081606 5141 and ch04_2020081607 0723]. I reviewed the video files. The video from both cameras is a long view of the termination of the pursuit and due to the distance and the angle of the cameras I was not able to see the Officer Involved Shooting. The following is a synopsis of the video files that captured the termination of the vehicle pursuit:

Video File: ch01_20200816063000

0631:24 hours-two cars enter the video traveling North bound at slow rate of speed and they pulled over to the curb.

0632:29 hours-the suspect vehicle enters the video traveling South bound at a slow rate of speed and comes to a stop. One patrol car enters the video traveling South bound at a slow rate of speed and almost simultaneously the two vehicles that pulled over to the curb drive away North bound and out of camera view. Several patrol cars enter the video and come to a stop several car lengths behind the suspect vehicle.

0632:33 hours-the front driver side door of the suspect vehicle opens and there is movement around the door. The video view is from a long distance and I am unable to see the person who opened the car door and what the person is doing.

0633:01 hours-one patrol car drives South bound and out of camera view.

0638:50 hours-several officers approach the suspect vehicle using a patrol car as cover.

0642:49 hours-personnel pushing a stretcher appear in camera view traveling South bound towards the suspect vehicle.

The additional video files associated to ch01 show a continued but limited view [due to the distance and angle] of the Hemet Police Department activity and medical response.

Video File: ch04_20200816063000

The camera view from ch04 is from a longer distance and smaller angle. The view of the suspect vehicle is distorted due to interference from a wrought iron fence that enclosed the dental office parking lot.

Hemet Pawn Shop Surveillance Video:

During the crime scene walkthrough, I noticed several surveillance cameras affixed to the outside of 529 N. San Jacinto Street. The building was vacant but had a sign on the window that identified Hemet Pawn Shop [951-765-0922] as the prior business. I called the phone number and spoke to Scott Larkin, the manager of Hemet Pawn Shop. Scott said the video cameras were shut down in February and they purchased new equipment when they moved into their new building.
