I collected the above stated evidence on the sidewalk ifo 2755 74th Ave. and turned it into the OPD Property Unit.

Summary:

On 21 Mar 09 I was at home on my day off when at approx. 1333hrs I received a call from Technician Middleton, who was also on her day off. She told me that she received a telephone call from on duty technician C.Cooper who told Middleton that two officers were down and she asked Middleton to come in. Middleton requested that I also respond.

I arrived at the technician detail at approx. 1430 hrs and started to load my equipment when a tow truck driver dropped off OPD veh #1924. I asked if the vehicle was from the shooting and the driver said it was. I saw vehicle damage to front of the veh and it was placed in a bay.

I responded to the scene in the 7400 blk of Macarthur Blvd. I met with Primary Technician Boyle (Please her report) She walked me through the scene. I was told that two motor officers, Sgt. Dunakin and Officer Hege had made a vehicle stop. The suspect fired shots at the two officers and they were in route to ACH. We heard that Sgt. Dunakin was pronounced. Officer Hege was on life support. Both had severe head wounds.

Summary: (Continued...)

I assisted at this scene by looking for further evidence. I met with Technician Middleton we were going to take measurements for her to draw up a rough scene diagram to prepare a diagram for interviews. At this time we heard the "Flash Bang" of the entry team making entry to 2755 74th Ave.

I heard gunshots after the "Flash Bang" and radio traffic of a "940-B / Officer Down". After taking cover I looked down the block and saw some members of the team removing a prone officer, later id as Sgt. Romans from the doorway of 2755. They went south to a police vehicle that transported Sgt. Romans to ACH with a major head wound.

Almost at the same time additional shots were heard. A second team member was carried out, later id as Sgt. Sakai. Knowing that the team members have limited mobility and dexterity I went to Sgt. Sakai to assist in first aid. I saw and felt that he too had a major head wound and was gasping for air. He was picked up and placed in the OPD "Bearcat" the tactical vehicle and transported to ACH. Both Sgt. Romans and Sgt. Sakai were pronounced.

At the scene in the 7400 blk of Macarthur Blvd. we realized that the diagram south on 74th Ave. to include 2755. We took measurements with a stroll meter and a rough scene diagram was drawn. Officer C. Hunt also assisted with the diagram.

There was an approaching storm with sprinkles, mist and rainfall on and off towards the later part of processing the scene. At the traffic stop killing I assisted in the collection of some of the evidence and non-essential items that were going to be damaged by the rain. I went to the sidewalk ifo. 2755 and the stated evidence was among the blood pools. I collected the items again to avoid further damage. Measurements were not taken of the individual items due to the fact they were removed after the shootings.

I secured the evidence at the technician detail and left for the night at approx. 2400 hrs.

I returned on 22 Mar 09 to package the evidence and write this report. The evidence was turned in at the end of my shift OPD Property Unit on 23 Mar 09.

Evidence:

Item #1 - (One) Slug, brass in copper jacketing, hollow point

Summary:

On 23 Mar 09 at approx. 1340 hrs. I spoke with Officer Hardgraves. He told me he was flagged down by (b)(5)(B) who was visiting the memorial to the officers located at the n/w corner of 74th Ave. & Macarthur Blvd. She looked down and found the slug. I met both I met with both parties ifo the Eastmont Sub-Station. I told Officer Hardgraves I would take care of the situation. In limited English (b)(5)(B) told me the same information on how she found the slug. I took the slug from her and she left.

I contacted Officer E. Ayala who speaks Spanish. He first spoke to (b)(5)(B) on the phone and then met with her to take a statement. Please see his Supplemental Report.

Technician Boyle who was turning in other evidence from these incidents, turned in the slug into the OPD Property Unit.
