SUBJECT: OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING, FID NO. 040-22

Honorable Members:

On July 11, 2023, the Honorable Board of Police Commissioners adjudicated Officer-Involved Shooting, Force Investigation Division (FID) No. 040-22, and adopted the findings of the Chief of Police for **Officer C. Hosea, Serial No. 43216**. The findings were as follows:

- **Tactics** – Administrative Disapproval (Adopted)
- **Drawing/Exhibiting** – In Policy, No Further Action (Adopted)
- **Lethal Use of Force** – Out of Policy, Administrative Disapproval (Adopted)

In determining the appropriate outcome for the Administrative Disapproval findings, I considered the following factors:

- The employee's work history including his discipline and use of force history
- The intent of the employee(s)
- The history of the involved unit
- The impact to officer safety
- Any impact to the community
- What remedy is best suited to change the behavior of the employee

Accordingly, I have determined that a Tactical Debrief along with Extensive Retraining and the initiation of a Personnel Complaint would be the most appropriate outcome in order to enhance Officer Hosea's future performance.
