**DETAILS:**

The following supplemental report is regarding an officer involved shooting incident that occurred on August 16, 2020 at 516 North San Jacinto in the city of Hemet. The suspect, later identified as Ysidro Espinoza, was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Officer Featherly was charted on August 16, 2020 by Riverside County District Attorney Senior Investigator Villalobos and Menifee Police Department Forensic Tech Keene. The charting consisted of digital photographs of Officer Featherly and documentation of Officer Featherly's uniform, equipment and service weapon. Sr. Investigator Villalobos charted Officer Featherly's service weapon; a Glock 21, serial number VLS939, .45 caliber Semi-automatic handgun with a Streamlight TLR-1 HL tactical light. Officer Featherly did not fire his weapon during the incident.

On August 19, 2020, at approximately 1456 hours, Officer Featherly agreed to meet me with me and provide a voluntary statement. The interview was conducted in a conference room at the Hemet Police Department. Detective Klinzing of the Hemet Police Department and Brandy Harper of Law Firm of Castillo Harper were also present during the interview. Per Hemet Police Department policy, officers can provide an uninterrupted statement prior to viewing video recordings of the incident. Officer Featherly chose to waive the uninterrupted statement and viewed video recording prior to providing a statement.

**SUMMARY OF OFFICER FEATHERLY'S INTERVIEW ON AUGUST 19, 2020:**

Officer Featherly provided a voluntary statement as to his involvement in the Officer Involved Shooting incident. The following is a synopsis of the interview with Officer Featherly. The statements may not be in the order in which they were provided, this was done to clarify the report as much as possible. Officer Featherly arrived on scene as the officer involved shooting occurred. Because Officer Featherly was not present at the time of the shooting, his statement was not submitted for transcription.

Officer Featherly and Officer Skaug were at the station when he heard Officer Schroeder advised over the radio that he was behind the suspect the detectives were looking for. Officer Featherly interpreted that statemesnt as Officer Schroeder was behind the homicide suspect. Officer Featherly and Officer Skaug left the station to assist Officer Schroeder.

Initially in the pursuit the suspect was driving erratic; speeding, running lights and driving on wrong side of the road. Officer Featherly was not actively in the pursuit, he remained several cars behind the pursuit and trailed. The pursuit went into San Jacinto and back into the city of Hemet. The suspect slowed down and ultimately stopped on San Jacinto.

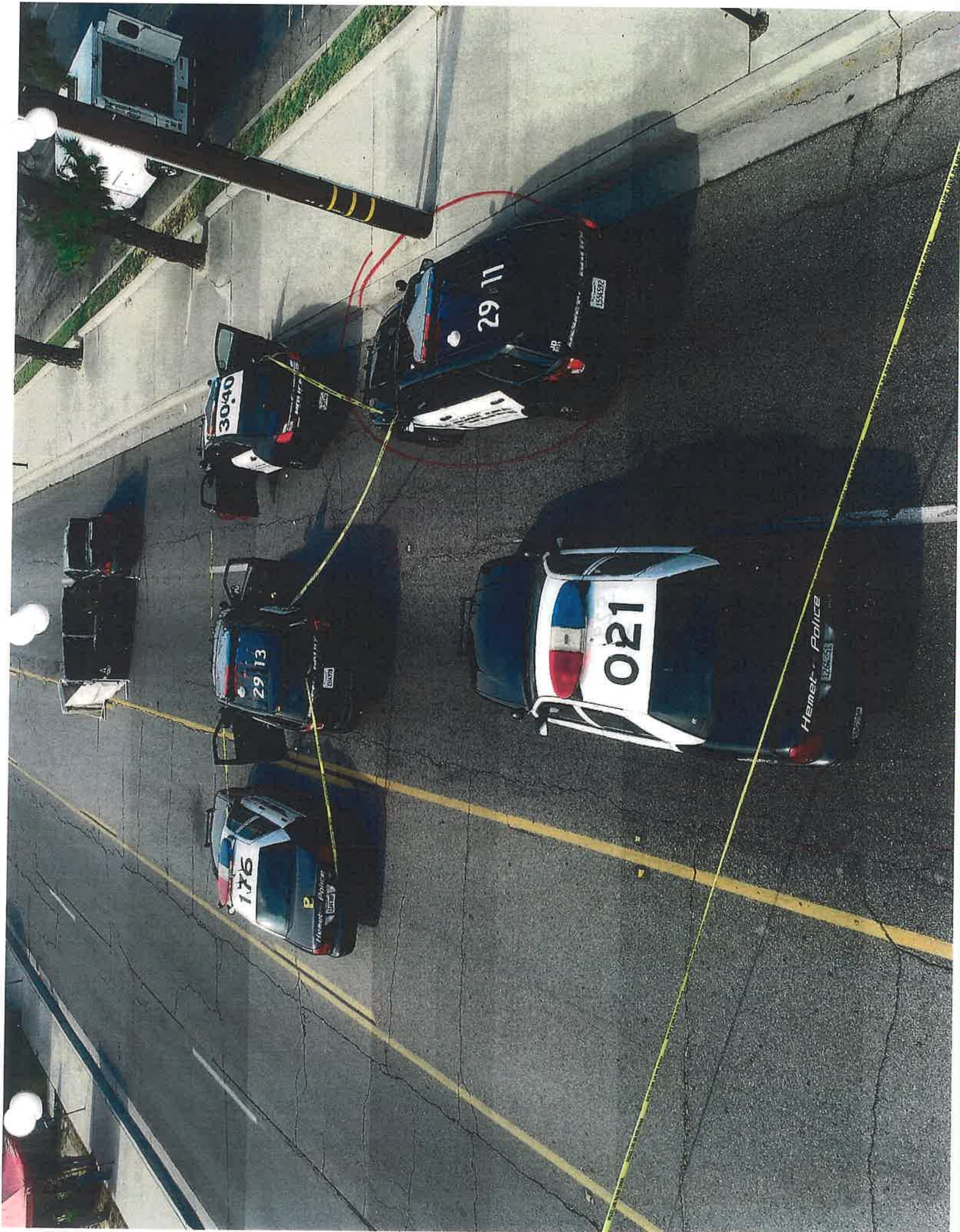
At the termination of the pursuit, Officer Featherly exited his unit and ran up to the next patrol unit. As Officer Featherly was running, the suspect exited his vehicle and shot himself in the head. Officer Featherly gave the suspect several verbal commands to drop the weapon and put his hands in the air. A tactical plan was in place to approach the suspect from the side while Officer Featherly and an additional officer provided cover on the vehicle. Officer Featherly assisted in checking the suspect vehicle trunk while other officers detained the suspect. Officer Featherly then proceeded to put of tape to secure the scene.

Officer Featherly stated he did not recognize Espinoza and stated he had not had any encounters with Espinoza in the past. During the interview, I presented Officer Featherly a picture of the scene of the officer involved shooting to refresh his recollection of the scene.



