DETAILS:

The following supplemental report is regarding an officer involved shooting incident that occurred on August 16, 2020 at 516 North San Jacinto in the city of Hemet. The suspect, later identified as Ysidro Espinoza, was pronounced deceased at the scene.

On August 19, 2020, at approximately 1948 hours, Sergeant Hall agreed to meet me with me and provide a voluntary statement. The interview was conducted in a conference room at the Hemet Police Department. Detective Klinzing of the Hemet Police Department was also present during the interview. Sergeant Hall declined having any attorney present and provided his statement voluntarily. Per Hemet Police Department policy, officers can provide an uninterrupted statement prior to viewing video recordings of the incident. Sergeant Hall chose to waive the uninterrupted statement and viewed video recording prior to providing a statement.

SUMMARY OF SERGEANT HALL'S INTERVIEW ON AUGUST 19, 2020:

Sergeant Hall provided a voluntary statement as to his involvement in the Officer Involved Shooting incident. The following is a synopsis of the interview with Sergeant Hall. The statements may not be in the order in which they were provided, this was done to clarify the report as much as possible. Sergeant Hall arrived on scene as the officer involved shooting occurred. Because Sergeant Hall was not present at the time of the shooting, his statement was not submitted for transcription.

Sergeant Hall was the morning watch commander. He remembered Officer Schroeder running plate that came back to a homicide suspect from the day before. Officer Schroeder attempted to stop the vehicle, but the driver failed to yield, and a pursuit was initiated. The pursuit went into San Jacinto and ultimately ended up on southbound San Jacinto in Hemet. Spike stripes were used to attempt to stop the pursuit, but the suspect avoided the stripes.

The suspect stopped on 500 North San Jacinto. When the suspect stopped the officers set up for a high-risk felony stop. Sergeant Hall stated three units were stopped to the right of his unit. As Sergeant Hall exited his vehicle he noticed the suspect's drivers side door open. The suspect made a very deliberate action, he put his feet out of the car and exited the car with a silver gun to his head. A moment later the suspect fired one round into his head. A fraction of a second later, officers fired several rounds at the suspect.

Sergeant Hall observed a truck facing the opposite direction of the felony stop. Sergeant Hall got back into his unit and drove past the suspect to contact the citizen. Sergeant Hall was unaware the citizens vehicle was struck by the gun fire. Sergeant Hall told the citizen to move his truck around the corner.

Sergeant Hall walked back to the felony stop and met up with Corporal Christianson. The suspect was still holding the handgun and the decision was made to shoot a bean bag rounds at the suspect in hopes he would drop the gun. The bean bag round struck the suspect but there was no reaction from the suspect. The team made a tactical approach and detained the suspect. Once the suspect was secured, officers began rendering medical aid.

Sergeant Hall ensured officers provided medical aid and he ensured the crime scene tape was set up. Sergeant Hall stood by as Corporal Christianson obtained the public safety statement from the two shooter officers.

During the interview, I presented Sergeant Hall a picture of the scene of the officer involved shooting to refresh his recollection of the scene.

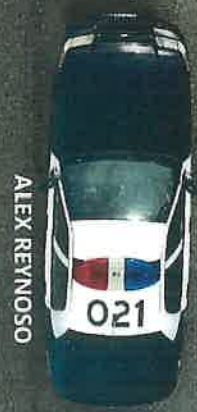


