Murphy #10702, Hemet Police Department Investigator D. Klinzing #10345 and I. A sketch of the location, including a log of the evidence collected will be included in HPD Property and Evidence Technician A. Murphy's #10702 report. HPD Officer M. Gomez #10348 assisted with the crime scene by taking 3 videos and 82 photographs of the crime scene with his department issued DJI Phantom 4 Pro sUAS drone. Refer to HPD Officer M Gomez's supplemental report for further information.

## Details:

This is a supplemental report to the Officer Involved Shooting incident which occurred at 560 N. San Jacinto Street, Hemet, California on August 16, 2020.

On Sunday, August 16, 2020, at approximately 0710 hours, I was contacted by Senior Investigator M. Moreno of the Riverside County District Attorney's Office Bureau of Investigations. Senior Investigator Moreno requested I respond to 560 N. San Jacinto Street, in the City of Hemet regarding an Officer Involved Shooting incident. The deceased suspect in this case was later identified as Ysidro Espinoza. I was present during the briefing by the Hemet Police Department and I participated in the walkthrough of the crime scene. Refer to my follow-up report on the details of the crime scene walkthrough and Senior Investigator Mario Moreno's follow-up report for details of the briefing.

On Sunday, August 16, 2020, HPD Property and Evidence Technician A. Murphy, HPS Investigator D. Klinzing and I began processing the crime scene where the Officer Involved Shooting (OIS) occurred. The location of the scene was in the South bound lanes of San Jacinto Street North approximately 265 feet North of the Curb Line Prolongation of Oakland Avenue on a four-lane paved road. The suspect vehicle, a green Toyota Avalon with CA-4YLD673 was straddling the lane divider of the South bound lanes approximately 260 feet North of the of the Curb Line Prolongation of Oakland Avenue. I located the following damage to the Toyota Avalon: damage to the right front bumper, yellow paint transfer on the driver side, side view mirror, an apparent grazing bullet mark to the outside of the driver side passenger door and the left front tire was flat.

A deceased male identified as Ysidro Ysidro Espinoza (4/29/90) was laying in the roadway just outside the driver side door of the Toyota Avalon. His hands were handcuffed behind his back.

There were five Hemet Police Department marked patrol vehicles parked behind the Toyota Avalon in various offset positions. The first patrol unit, Officer Detwiler's patrol unit #3040 with CA Exempt 1395732, was parked behind the Toyota Avalon offset to the passenger side of the car facing South. The second patrol unit, Officer Schroeder's patrol unit #2913 with CA Exempt 1554978, was parked behind the Toyota Avalon offset to the driver side of the car facing South. The third patrol unit, Corporal Christianson's patrol unit # 3176 with CA Exempt 1164789, was parked behind the Toyota Avalon offset to the driver side of the car and to the left of Officer Schroeder's patrol unit facing South. The fourth patrol unit, Officer Featherly's patrol unit #2911 with CA Exempt 1554592, was parked behind Officer Detwiler's patrol unit #3040 slightly offset to the driver side of patrol unit #3040 facing South. The fifth patrol unit, Officer

Reynoso's patrol unit #3021 with CA Exempt 12643651, was parked behind Officer Schroeder's patrol unit #2913 offset to the passenger side of patrol unit #2913 facing South.

Identified evidence listed above was booked into evidence at the Hemet Police Department by HPD Property and Evidence Technician A. Murphy #10702. Refer to Hemet Police Department Property and Evidence Technician A. Murphy's #10702 supplemental report under Hemet PD DR# 20-6129 for further details concerning the crime scene search, evidence collection and measurements.

### **Processing of The Body**

At 1150 hours, we paused the identifying and marking the evidence to process the decedent, Ysidro Espinoza. The temperature was approximately 105 degrees and Deputy Coroner N. Townsend recommended no further delay in processing the body due to the extreme heat and the effects it would have on the body as it laid on the hot pavement. Espinoza was lying face up on the roadway just outside the driver side of the Toyota Avalon and his hands were handcuffed behind his back. The following is a description of Espinoza's clothing: black t-Shirt; tan shorts with a dark cloth belt; black socks, and black shoes. Espinoza was also wearing a short, black compression type sleeve on his left forearm, a long, black compression type sleeve on his right arm that covered the lower portion of his bicep, past his elbow and the upper portion of his forearm, and a pink bracelet on his left wrist.

Deputy Coroner N. Townsend recommended removing the clothing at the Coroner's office. The following wounds/injuries were located at the scene: apparent gunshot entry wound to the right temple; apparent graze wound above the right eyebrow; apparent gunshot wound on the left bicep; apparent gunshot wound on the right tricep; and an apparent gunshot wound on the left chest above the nipple. Deputy Coroner N. Townsend swabbed Espinoza's left hand for GSR at 1211 hours and swabbed his right hand for GSR at 1212 hours. Deputy Coroner N. Townsend and Sergeant C. James placed Espinoza in a body bag and the bag was sealed at 1226 hours. Deputy Coroner N. Townsend had to unseal the bag to place Espinoza's shoes inside the bag and collect a blood sample. Deputy Coroner N. Townsend resealed the bag at 1235 hours.

### **Location of Witness James Lancaster's Chevrolet Silverado [CA-7Z32126]**

During the crime scene walkthrough HPD Investigator D. Klinzing pointed out a tan Chevrolet Silverado with CA-7Z32126 that was parked on Oakland Avenue just East of San Jacinto Street North facing West bound. Investigator D. Klinzing said according to Sgt. M. Hall #10108, the owner of the Chevrolet Silverado, James Lancaster (5/2/86) was a witness to the OIS. James was the sole occupant of his vehicle and was stopped along the curb on San Jacinto Street North, North of Oakland Avenue. James said his vehicle was struck by gun fire during the OIS. Sgt M. Hall asked James to move his vehicle and he parked it in the location we found the vehicle during the crime scene walkthrough. Investigator D. Klinzing pointed out the approximate location of the Chevrolet Silverado when it was struck by gunfire. It appeared the Chevrolet Silverado was stationary North bound on San Jacinto Street North, North of Oakland Avenue adjacent to the bus bench and there was a large pool of liquid on the ground. There was also liquid on the ground just below the area of the radiator where the truck was parked on Oakland Avenue. Investigator D. Klinzing pointed out an apparent bullet impact in the front of the grill of James's truck.

### **Transportation of the 2002 Toyota Avalon [CA-4YLD673]**

HPD Officer Maynard #10763 completed the CHP-180 Vehicle Report for the 2002 Toyota Avalon [CA-7Z32126]. Officer Maynard assisted Castellano's Tow with recovering the vehicle and he followed the tow truck to the HPD Evidence Lot. Personnel from Castellano's Tow did not enter the vehicle or reach through the open windows. Officer Maynard confirmed the Evidence Lot was secured. Refer to Officer Maynard's follow-up report and the CHP-180 for further details.

### **Transportation of the 2006 Chevrolet Silverado [CA-7Z32126]**

I requested that the 2006 Chevrolet Silverado [CA-7Z32126] be transported to the HPD Evidence Lot pending obtaining a search warrant to search the vehicle for the expended round that appeared to have pierced the radiator.

Officer Maynard #10763 completed the CHP-180 Vehicle Report. Officer Maynard assisted Castellano's Tow with recovering the vehicle and he followed the tow truck to the HPD Evidence Lot. Personnel from Castellano's Tow did not enter the vehicle or reach through the open windows. Officer Maynard confirmed the Evidence Lot was secured. Refer to Officer Maynard's follow-up report and the CHP-180 for further details

1 On 08/16/2020 at approximately 0700 hours, I was contacted via cell phone by Detective Wood. He  
2 asked that I respond to the Hemet Police Department located at 450 E. Latham Avenue, in the City of  
3 Hemet, County of Riverside. Once I arrived at the Hemet Police Department, Corporal Alvarez  
4 requested that I respond to San Jacinto Street and Oakland Avenue, in the City of Hemet, County of  
5 Riverside, to assist in processing a scene. I arrived at San Jacinto Street and Oakland Avenue and  
6 Investigator Klinzing gave me a walk-through of the scene. As he was giving me a walk through he  
7 asked me to take overall photographs of the scene. He also requested that I take overall exterior  
8 photographs of all units at the scene and document approximate measurements of Officer Schroeder's  
9 unit #2913 (CA Exempt-1554978), Officer Detwiler's unit #3040 (CA Exempt-1395762), Officer  
10 Featherly's unit #2911 (CA Exempt-1554592), Officer Al. Reynoso's unit #3021 (CA Exempt-  
11 1264351), Corporal Christianson's unit #3176 (CA Exempt-1164789), and a green Toyota (CA-  
12 4YLD673). Investigator Klinzing also asked me to take exterior photographs a tan Chevy Silverado  
13 (CA, 7Z32126) He also pointed to a deceased male in the roadway. I began by taking overall exterior  
14 photographs of all Officer units and the green Toyota (CA, 4YLD673).

15  
16 Riverside Sheriff's Coroner's Deputy Townsend then began to conduct her investigation. As she  
17 conducted her investigation, I photographed the process. Deputy Townsend removed a pair of  
18 handcuffs from the deceased male's wrist and I collected them as evidence. As she was conducting her  
19 investigation, she located a key fob in the deceased male's right arm compression sleeve. I  
20 photographed the key fob and assigned it an item number (item #1). I then collected the key fob as  
21 evidence. After I photographed the assigned tag to the body bag, Deputy Townsend stated she needed  
22 to open the body bag and add the deceased male's shoes. She added another tag to the resealed body  
23 bag and I photographed it. I collected a gun shot residue kit from Deputy Townsend.

1 After Deputy Townsend was finished processing the deceased male, Senior Investigator Quilantan  
2 from the District Attorney's Office, Investigator Klinzing and I began to process the scene. As Senior  
3 Investigator Quilantan and Investigator Klinzing pointed to items they wanted collected as evidence, I  
4 assigned them an item number and I photographed them. Investigator Klinzing assisted me with  
5 measuring the approximate distance of all of the Officer units, green Toyota, and all numbered items  
6 with the exception of numbered items located in the green Toyota. Investigator Klinzing and I used a  
7 department issued roll tape and we measured all Officer units, green Toyota, and numbered items  
8 using the north curb line prolongation of Oakland Avenue and the west curb line of San Jacinto Street.  
9 When we were finished measuring, I collected all numbered items as evidence (see pages 6 through 7).  
10 All possible blood swab samples were collected using clean cotton tipped swabs and distilled water.  
11 All collected items were secured in my truck and later booked into evidence. A CD with 615  
12 photographs of the scene was booked into evidence.

13  
14 After I was finished processing the scene, I responded to the Hemet Police Department to chart Officer  
15 Detwiler's 12 GA Shotgun (SN: V512838V) with five 12 GA rounds and his Colt Defense 5.56mm  
16 AR-15 (SN: A0222611). Each firearm was displayed and photographed. After the charting was  
17 completed, I booked the firearms into evidence (see page 8). All photographs of the charting were  
18 included in the CD of 615 photographs of the scene that was previously mentioned above.

19  
20 On 08/20/2020 at approximately 0700 hours, I responded to 401 N. Juanita Street (LP Denny  
21 Building), in the City of Hemet, with Detective Willison and Senior Investigator Quilantan to process  
22 the green Toyota (CA, 4YLD673). Senior Investigator Quilantan asked me to take overall exterior and  
23 interior photographs of the green Toyota. Once I was finished taking overall photographs of the green  
24 Toyota, Senior Investigator Quilantan and Detective Willison began searching the vehicle. As Senior

Investigator Quilantan and Detective Willison pointed to items, I assigned them an item number and photographed them. I then collected all numbered items as evidence (see pages 9 through 10). All collected items were secured in my truck and later booked into evidence. I booked item #1 (Kodiak Case w/ ID & Letter) under case number 20-6129. Item #1 was checked out by Detective Willison on 08/20/2020 and when he checked item #1 back in he requested item #1 to be moved to case number 20-6121. A CD with 226 photographs of the green Toyota was booked into evidence.

On 08/21/2020 at approximately 0700 hours, I responded to 401 N. Juanita Street (LP Denny Building) with Investigator Klinzing and Senior Investigator Quilantan to assist in processing a tan Chevy Silverado (CA, 7Z32126). Senior Investigator Quilantan asked me to take overall exterior and interior photographs of the tan Chevy Silverado. After I finished taking overall photographs of the tan Chevy Silverado, Investigator Klinzing and Senior Investigator Quilantan opened the hood of the vehicle. I photographed underneath the hood of the vehicle as is. Investigators began to search underneath the hood of the tan Chevy Silverado and located a possible bullet hole. Investigator Klinzing assisted me in holding a trajectory rod through the possible bullet hole and I photographed it. A CD with 95 photographs of the tan Chevy Silverado was booked into evidence.
