**NARRATIVE**

**NOTIFICATION:** On 5-16-20, at approximately 1637 hours, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] to process the scene of obstructing a police officer. RPD Dispatch advised the suspect was tased by one of RPD Officers.

**OBSERVATIONS:** Upon arrival, I met with a number of RPD Officers and suspect Krystle Hasket. Suspect Hasket was handcuffed and was laying on the sidewalk IFO [REDACTED]. I saw she had a moderate amount of blood on both of her hands. I was unable to locate the source of the blood.

On the sidewalk, next to Hasket, I saw a spent taser projectile (#C41072A1H). The spent probes with the spent taser doors were also next to Hasket. I inspected Hasket for visible injuries and I saw the taser probes puncture wounds were in the back side of her right shoulder/right side of upper back.

I photographed Hasket and collected the spent taser cartridge for evidence.

I next responded to 2021 Florida Ave. where I met with Officer J. Guzman. I also obtained photographs of a silver/black air pistol (BB gun).

**NARRATIVE**

On 05/16/20, at 1628 hours, I responded to S. 20th Street and Florida Ave to conduct an impound on an unoccupied hit-and-run vehicle. I arrived on scene and located the 2005 Nissan Altima (# [REDACTED]) along the south curb of Florida Ave, just east of S. 20th Street. The vehicle was facing eastbound in the middle of the sidewalk and wedged between an electrical post and a resident's parked vehicle. The front right wheel and bumper had major damage.

I requested a tow through dispatch and Checker's Towing responded. Prior to the tow, I conducted a search for inventory. The vehicle was towed pursuant to 22655(a) CVC, held pending hit and run investigation. I documented photographs of the damage and uploaded them to the Axon Capture application.

At 1815 hours, I contacted Richmond Records Specialist Phan to enter the impound.

**NARRATIVE**

On 05/16/20, at approximately 1836 hours, I responded to the 100 block of S. 20th Street on reports of a female possibly armed with a firearm. Upon arrival, I observed several Richmond officers in a physical altercation with a black female adult (identified as Krystle HASKET). HASKET was gripping the handrail IFO a residence and refusing to let go for officer to detain her. HASKET was pulling away from officers and refused to submit both of her hands for handcuffing.

HASKET was ultimately detained in handcuffs outside the residence. I was instructed by Officer J. Guzman to conduct a witness statement from a neighbor (identified as [REDACTED]) who lives at [REDACTED]. I contacted [REDACTED] IFO her residence and she told me the following in summary:

Prior to police arrival, she was working on her yard which faces east towards S. 20th Street. She noticed a vehicle swerving southbound on S. 20th at a high rate of speed, and the vehicle was not keeping a straight path as it was traveling southbound. She was not able to confirm who was driving the vehicle, but she believed it was her neighbor who lives a few houses north of her residence. [REDACTED] described the female as a black lady, heavy set, wearing a red shirt and dark pants.

[REDACTED] saw the vehicle crash in front of a residence near S. 20th Street and Florida Ave. One of the (male) residents exited from the yard where the vehicle crashed. It appeared the female was walking away from the area of the crash. Again, [REDACTED] could not confirm that the female was operating the vehicle. A loud argument erupted between the female and the male resident. She could not audibly hear what the two parties were saying, however the argument was loud enough to cause many other neighbors to exit their residences. After a short argument, the female walked northbound on S. 20th Street and Richmond officers contacted her.

[REDACTED] stated that the female appeared intoxicated, and that she usually doesn't "act like that".



While responding, information was provided that the person who had the gun was the "neighbor" or possibly the female. The female was described as a black, female, adult, heavy set wearing a red shirt and faded jeans.

Upon arrival, my vehicle's emergency lights were on at the intersection of 20th St. and Ohio Ave. I saw a female matching the above mentioned description walking southbound from 20th Street and Florida Ave. Upon exiting the vehicle, efforts were made to detain the female, later identified as S-Hasket, who was at the time, possibly armed with a handgun and leaving the scene of a collision. S-Hasket was ordered to get on the ground and make her hands visible multiple times. She looked directly at officers and blatantly ignored the commands. She instead walked towards the front door at [REDACTED]. At the time, I did not know if she was attempting to flee into her own residence or occupy the residence of another person while armed with a handgun. In order to prevent escape and to minimize the possibly of letting the situation escalate to a life-threatening emergency, Officer O. Guzman and I elected to run towards her and made efforts to pull her back away from the front door.

I grabbed S-Hasket's shirt, which immediately ripped as she pulled away from me and continued towards the front door. I then grabbed her right arm and made an effort to place her arm in an arm bar to place her in handcuffs. The situation unfolded in a confined short stairway enclosed tightly by a rail and the wall of the residence. I noticed S-Hasket gripped with rail with her left hand. Officer O. Guzman attempted to gain control of her left hand as I held her right hand. S-Hasket was repeatedly told to stop resisting and comply, which she decided to ignore. She yelled at Officer O. Guzman's face "Let go!" S-Hasket maintained grip of the bar and attempted to pull her right hand away from my grip. The resident at [REDACTED] said, "Babe stop resisting them.... Let go of the bar." Officers were able to release her grip of the bar and she immediately placed both hands underneath her chest while laying down on her stomach, preventing officers from handcuffing her and safely search her for any weapons. S-Hasket looked up at Officer Khalfan as he placed the drive-stun tazer on her right shoulder and refused to comply. Officer Khalfan activated the drive-stun tazer on her right shoulder, which was ineffective in gaining compliance. After, Officer Khalfan attached to deployable prongs to his tazer and announced "Tazer" moments before he deployed the tazer prongs. The prongs connected with her right shoulder and was also ineffective in gaining her compliance. Officer O. Guzman then approached her left side and was able to pull her left arm out and placed it behind her back. Sergeant Bashan placed the handcuff on her left hand and Officers continued to struggle to take her right arm out from under her chest. Officer O. Guzman used my baton to pry her arm out and it was effective. I assisted in placing S-Hasket's right hand in handcuffs. I should be noted that throughout this interactions, I detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath, indicating that she was likely under the influence of an alcoholic beverage.

Paramedics were requested to respond for tazer deployment and a cut on the hand that she sustained during the struggle and caused moderate bleeding. I placed S-Hasket in the recovery position and Officer Nurko searched her for any weapons and non were located. She said she was tazed three times when she was not fighting or resisting and just trying to walk in her house. I asked her if she was not holding on to the fence. She told me she never held on to the fence and said she only put her hands at her chest.

At this point, the interview was concluded.

I read S-Hacket the admin per se from the DMV form and she elected to provide a breath sample at 1802. I conducted the fifteen minute observation period to make sure she did not consume or regurgitate. I then administered the test at 1817 by using the Intox-DMT breath machine (Serial #500503-50). With two samples, the Intox-DMT provided a result of .091 BAC. I informed S-Hacket that the breath test does not retain a sample for future testing. If she wanted, she could provide a blood sample in the event she needed it for future testing, but she declined.

Based on the above listed evidence and statement's collected during the investigation, S-Hacket was issued a citation for committing the offenses of PC 23152(a), CVC 20002, PC 148 (a)(1), and PC 243(a). Upon issuing the citation, S-Hacket was released into the custody of her wife ([REDACTED]). [REDACTED] was accompanied by her brother ([REDACTED]). A records check of [REDACTED] showed he had a valid license and [REDACTED] signed the release of liability form for taking custody of S-Hacket.

**NARRATIVE**

On May 17, 2020, at 0629 hours, I was on duty working patrol for the Richmond Police Department assigned as 2L4. I was wearing the department issued uniform and drove a marked black and white patrol vehicle. I had a police department patch on each shoulder and a badge on the left side of the chest. I was dispatched 2021 Florida Avenue in Richmond for the report of a person armed with a gun. The suspect, described as a heavy set black female wearing a red shirt with faded pants, was on the sidewalk harassing neighbors. The suspect was last seen walking on 20th Street from Florida Avenue towards Ohio Avenue.

When I arrived, my attention was drawn to a heavy set black female adult who was wearing a red shirt. The suspect, later identified as Krystle Hasket, was walking from Florida Avenue towards Ohio Avenue. I noticed citizens down the street pointing at Hasket.

I contacted Hasket and yelled at her, "Let me see your hands. Hands up! Hands up!" Hasket kept her arms down and continued walking northbound on the west curb of 20th Street. I saw her pacing towards the front door of [REDACTED] not following my commands to get on the ground.

Fearing she did not live at [REDACTED], the fact that dispatch reported she was possibly armed with a firearm, Hasket not following my commands to get on the ground, I believed someone could have gotten hurt if she walked in the residence.

I grabbed Hasket's shirt and pulled her back preventing her from walking inside the residence. I told Hasket, "Stop. Stop resisting" but she tensed her arms, pulled away, and continued trying to enter the house.

Hasket used her left hand to grab on to a metal handrail that was in front of [REDACTED]. Hasket grabbed on and used it to pull herself forward while I told her "Stop resisting!" Hasket continued tensing her arms and did not follow my instructions.

I continued yelling "Stop resisting" at Hasket because she would not loosen her grip on the handrail. I made several attempts to have Hasket loosen her grip, but she would not let go of the handrail. Hasket continued tensing her arms, kept a tight grip, and started to yell something the effect of "we are not human!"

I told Hasket to let go of the handrail multiple times but she refused. Hasket continued yelling and would not loosen her grip. Officers continued telling Hasket to let go of the rail, but she refused and continued yelling.

I reposition myself behind Hasket and managed to loosen her grip from the handrail. I immediately felt Hasket tense her arm, pulling her arm towards her chest, and trying to pull away. Hasket managed to pull both of her arms away from officers and place them against her chest. Hasket bent forward and did not follow my commands when I told her to give us her hands.

The area in between the metal handrail and the wall to [REDACTED] limited my mobility due to it being a confined space. There was only approximate two and a half feet of clearance between the handrail and the wall. There were three officers, to include myself, trying to gain control of Hasket in the confined space.

Officer J. Guzman pulled Hasket out of the confined space to have better control of the situation. I feared she was not complying with officers because she was possibly armed. Based on my training and experience the area of the front of the waist is an area where officers commonly conceal firearms.

I started yelling "Put your hands behind your back" but Hasket did not follow my instructions. Hasket tensed her arms, pressed her arms against her chest and would not follow officers instructions.

Officers continued yelling "Put your hands behind your back" but she did not listen. Hasket kept her arms under her body leading me to believe she was trying to conceal a weapon. I grabbed Hasket's left arm from under her body and pulled it out. Throughout the entire time Hasket tensed her arms, pulled her arm away from me, and did not cooperate.

Officers managed to gain control of Hasket's left arm. Hasket kept her right arm tucked under her body. Hasket would not place her hand behind her back as instructed. I used a wooden baton to pry Hasket's right arm from under her body. Officers were able to gain control of Hasket's arms and place her in handcuffs.

Refer to Officer J. Guzman's report for additional information.

I conducted a neighborhood check at [REDACTED]. I spoke with [REDACTED] who was outside the entire incident. [REDACTED] immediately stated that he did not believe Hasket was armed but she did flee the scene of a collision. I interviewed [REDACTED] and obtained the following statement in summary.

On May 16, 2020, at approximately 1615 hours, [REDACTED] was outside of [REDACTED] when she observed Hasket driving southbound on South 20th Street and saw her turn eastbound on Florida Avenue. [REDACTED] stayed outside and did not see Hasket.

Approximately 20 minutes later, [REDACTED] noticed Hasket driving southbound at a high rate of speed. Hasket turned east, lost control, and collided with the curb and a pole on the south curb of Florida Avenue. Hasket nearly crashed into the fence on the front lawn of the residence. Hasket exited her vehicle and got into an argument with the person who lived at the residence. [REDACTED] last saw Hasket walk southbound on South 20th Street from Florida Avenue prior to police arrival.

It should be noted that my body camera was activated throughout the initial portion of the incident. Once the scene was rendered safe and the suspect was detained I noticed my camera was turned off. It is unknown if the camera malfunctioned or if the camera was turned off as a result of the altercation.

**NARRATIVE**

On Saturday, May 16, 2020, at approximately 1630 hours, I responded to the area of 2021 Florida Ave regarding a subject with a gun call. It was reported a heavy set black female who was wearing a red shirt and faded jeans had crashed her vehicle and left the scene. The reporting party believed the female had a gun.

Prior to my arrival RPD Officers advised they were out with the suspect on S. 20th and Ohio Ave. I arrived on scene and located RPD Officers in a struggle with the suspect who was later identified as Krystle Hasket. Hasket was in a struggle with Officers standing on the stairway to the residence.

I assisted by grabbing Hasket's right leg, and pulling her out of the stairway area in order to be able to provide more space for Officer's to be able to attempt to control both of her hands. At the time based on the information provided, Hasket was believed to be armed with a firearm. Once Hasket was on the ground, she was facing down and concealed both of her hands under her chest. I was not able to see Hasket's hands. I knew it was important to gain control of Hasket's hands before she could reach down into her waistband area. Based on my training and experience, the waist band area is a common place firearms are concealed on a person. I was in fear Hasket was concealing her hands in an attempt to access the mentioned firearm.

I gave Hasket an order to give me her hand or she would be Tased. Hasket refused to comply. I drew my Taser and based on how close Hasket was to me removed the cartridge. I placed the Taser in the upper right portion of Hasket's back and attempted to conduct a drive stun. I cycled the drive stun for approximately 2 seconds which I immediately saw was unsuccessful. I placed the cartridge back into my Taser and deployed it. The darts made contact with Hasket's upper right shoulder. The Taser cycled a full cycle. I ordered Hasket to place her hands behind her back but she still concealed her hands and refused to comply. I cycled the Taser a second cycle and Hasket still kept her right hand concealed.

Officer's were eventually able to gain control of Hasket's hands and she was placed in handcuffs.

AMR #67 arrived on scene and treated Hasket. CSI Zeidan collected the Taser cartridge. Ofc. Nurko took custody of Hasket.

This contact was captured on my RPD issued body worn AVR.

**NARRATIVE**

On 05/16/20 at approximately 1634 hrs., I was on duty working as a Patrol Team 4 Sergeant. I was dressed in full police uniform and driving a fully marked vehicle, unit #1146. I responded to the area of Ohio Ave. / S. 20th St. for a hit and run suspect who was possibly armed with a firearm. Callers described her as a heavy set Black female wearing a red shirt.

Upon arrival I saw a group of officers struggling with a heavy set Black female on the west sidewalk of S. 20th St. The female was screaming and face down with both hands concealed underneath her body. Officers were telling her to put her hands behind her back. The female, later identified by her CDL as A/ Krystle HASKET, refused to comply. Officer Khalfan's taser deployment was ineffective. HASKET refused to show her hands. It took multiple officers and a wood baton applied as leverage to pry her arms out from underneath her body. I placed a handcuff on HASKET's left wrist, and a double handcuff due to her size, on her right wrist. HASKET's family had been yelling loudly at us throughout this encounter. At one point yelling, "she's drunk! She's a drunk mother fucker".

Once HASKET was handcuffed we rolled her onto her left side in a recovery position, and requested AMR respond.

I requested a CSI respond for photos and to recover the taser AFIDS and probes.

Officers then responded to the original scene of the vehicle collision at Florida Ave. / S. 20th St., as well as conducted neighborhood checks and attempted to contact the 911 callers.

I spoke to two males who had been standing on the west sidewalk of S. 20th St. watching our interaction with HASKET. They were reluctant to speak with me but stated HASKET was their niece and a friend, and she had been drinking at a birthday party earlier. They were unaware if she had psychological problems, and said they did not know her to carry a firearm. The males declined to identify themselves.

I spoke to HASKET's family members who were inside [REDACTED]. A female who verbally identified herself as O/ [REDACTED], said she was HASKET's wife. [REDACTED] provided the following statement, in summary:

HASKET and [REDACTED] were home drinking and celebrating [REDACTED] birthday today. They got into a verbal argument about throwing water on each other. HASKET left to get ice at the store, but she "shouldn't have been driving". [REDACTED] denied that HASKET had any psychological problems, but said perhaps she started "drinking too early", and that is what led to this behavior.

I handed HASKET's keys and wallet to [REDACTED].

At about 1628 hours, I responded to South 20th and Ohio Ave on a report of vehicle collision where the driver fled the scene and had a firearm.

Upon arrival, Officer J Guzman and Officer O Guzman told the suspect, later identified as Hasket, to stop. She did not comply.

Hasket continued to walk north bound on the west curb line of South 20th Street and attempted to enter into [REDACTED]. Officer J Guzman and Officer O Guzman grabbed Hasket to detain her.

Hasket held onto the hand rail of the stair way that lead to the front porch of the residence. Hasket refused to let go. I reached around the front of Hasket's body and attempted to break her grip of the bar. Hasket temporarily released her grip, I tried to regrip her arm and she grabbed onto the bar again. I was unsuccessful at another attempt on her grip on the bar, and Hasket was dragged down the stairs to be handcuffed.

Hasket was forcefully removed from the stairs due to close proximity with irate family members inside the residence, and to obtain a safer positioning for handcuffing.

Hasket continued to not comply with commands and restricted her arms underneath her body. I attempted to pull Hasket's left arm from under her body, and I was unsuccessful. Officer Khalfan deployed his taser and Hasket continued to resist.

I placed Hasket's legs into a figure four leg lock, and she was detained in handcuffs without further incident.

My AVR was activated.
