DETAILS:

On August 16, 2020, I (Sr. Investigator M. Moreno #MM395) was assigned to investigate an officer involved shooting incident, involving officers from the Hemet Police Department that occurred at 560 N. San Jacinto in the city of Hemet, County of Riverside.

The suspect, later identified as Ysidro Espinoza, was declared deceased on scene. Due to the location of the body, a blanket was placed over Espinoza's body. During the course of the investigation, I was informed Espinoza's sisters, later identified as Rosalie Ribera and Maria Leanos, had entered the crime scene and uncovered Espinoza's body.

On August 16, 2020, at approximately 1000 hours, I was advised Rosalie Ribera returned to the scene to provide a statement. Riverside County DA Investigator Villalobos and I contacted and interviewed Rosalie Ribera. The interview was audio recorded. The audio recording was sent to a transcription service to be transcribed. The audio recording was later booked into evidence at the Riverside County District Attorney's Office.

During the interview, Ribera confirmed that she had been in communication with Ysidro Espinoza prior to the officer involved shooting. She stated he called her in the early morning hours and admitted to her that he killed "Lalo". Espinoza told her he caught his ex-cheating on him with his friend Lalo. Espinoza told her he shot Lalo and that he was not going to jail. Ribera believed her brother was suicidal and statement Espinoza had been placed on a 5150 hold in the past.

During the course of the investigation, I learned Rosalie Ribera had passed away from an unrelated illness.

2 MORENO: Well, as soon as we get the scene processed, ma'am. We have to photograph,
3 collect evidence and the c- your sister has a card number - I'm sorry, she has a
4 card from the Coroner's that...

10 MAN: Yeah, we (unintelligible).

12 MORENO: Yeah, we gave - the coroner came and talked to your sister. Gave her a card that

1 SWINDLE: I have to smoke, sorry guys.

3 MORENO: That's fine.

5 MAN: It's all right.

7 SWINDLE: Ah, 1387 Reinhart, R-E-I-N-H-A-R-T, Street: San Jacinto.
8
9 MORENO: And just so I know this is clear, you're Ysidro's sister?
10
11 SWINDLE: Yeah.
12
13 MORENO: Okay. And your date of birth, Rosalie?
14
15 SWINDLE: 8-26-81.
16
17 MORENO: Um, I want to ask you some questions about your brother as far as his - like I
18 said, we're here for - for the officer-involved shooting, okay?
19
20 SWINDLE: Mm-hm.
21
22 MORENO: Not - I don't know anything that's happening with the investigation that Hemet
23 PD's got going on.
24
25 SWINDLE: So where was the officer-involved shooting? This right here.
26
27 MORENO: Right here - right here.
28
29 SWINDLE: So he didn't shoot himself?
30
31 MORENO: Ah, that's what...
32
33 MAN: We're still doing the investigation. Still the investigation is pending.
34
35 SWINDLE: Okay.
36

2 MORENO: I think m- there's a possibility there was an officer shot, he shot himself, we're
3 still figuring that out, okay?
4
5 SWINDLE: Okay.
6
7 MORENO: Like I said, we're not gonna know until we collect all the evidence...
8
9 SWINDLE: Okay.
10
11 MORENO: ...and process the scene.
12
13 SWINDLE: But that's what (unintelligible) is right now.
14
15 MORENO: There was a - there - officers did - were involved in the shooting.
16
17 SWINDLE: Okay.
18
19 MORENO: I'm not sure which was the lethal or what happened, okay?
20
21 SWINDLE: Okay.
22
23 MORENO: But there was officers involved in the shooting. There is also possibility that he -
24 it was self-inflicted.
25
26 SWINDLE: Okay.
27
28 MORENO: Once we process the scene and everything, we'll get - it'll be more clarified on
29 that.
30
31 SWINDLE: Okay - okay. But yeah, everyone's, like, sending me all this stuff. They're like
32 Hemet News and, you know...
33
34 MORENO: Don't listen to that.
35
36

1 SWINDLE: Yeah.
2
3 MORENO: Any questions, you have my card, you have his card. It's got all of our
4 information on there.
5
6 SWINDLE: (Unintelligible) like, I mean, I was here but they stopped me from - I mean, I
7 jumped out of the truck. I mean, we were following behind the cops.
8
9 MORENO: Okay.
10
11 SWINDLE: So...
12
13 MORENO: So you have (unintelligible).
14
15 MAN: That's what we need to talk to you about.
16
17 SWINDLE: Yeah.
18
19 MAN: That's what we need to find out, what - what...
20
21 MORENO: So Ysidro had called you...
22
23 SWINDLE: Yeah.
24
25 MORENO: ...during this whole pursuit and everything?
26
27 SWINDLE: Yep.
28
29 MORENO: Did he tell you what was goin' on?
30
31 SWINDLE: Yeah.
32
33 MORENO: What was his - what was his thinking? What was going on in his mind?
34
35 SWINDLE: He said he wasn't going to jail.
36

2 MORENO: Okay. Why was he...
3
4 SWINDLE: I mean...
5
6 MORENO: Is he on probation or parole or anything like that?
7
8 SWINDLE: No, because he killed Lalo last night at the park.
9
10 MORENO: He told you he did?
11
12 SWINDLE: Yeah.
13
14 MORENO: Okay.
15
16 MAN: Hm.
17
18 MORENO: So - okay. Now did he say that he was gonna...
19
20 SWINDLE: He said he put two in his head.
21
22 MAN: Okay. Why?
23
24 SWINDLE: Because he's been fucking his sister-in-law. And Lalo is one of my brother's best
25 friends.
26
27 MAN: Oh, really?
28
29 SWINDLE: Yeah, they been friends since they were kids.
30
31 MAN: Oh, okay.
32
33 SWINDLE: And my sister-in-law, she has a drinking problem. My brother has a drug
34 problem. Everyone knows it. They've been going through it. And her son found
35 text messages, um, that she had been, like, going out on my brother. And then
36

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1 my brother kept from me, because me and him were the closest. There's six of
2 us.
3
4 MORENO: Right.
5
6 SWINDLE: And, um, he said - he was like - when he called me last night, he said - you
7 know, he's like, "I didn't say anything sooner 'cause it was too close to home."
8 He's like, "And I don't want you to do anything. You're all our family has." I
9 said, "Okay, who is it?" And he said, "Lalo." And I said, "So what do you want
10 to do?" And he said, "I already put two in his fucking head." I said, "Where are
11 you at? I'm coming wherever you are."
12
13 MORENO: Yeah.
14
15 SWINDLE: That's my little brother, man, you know? Like...
16
17 MORENO: Mm-hm. I get it.
18
19 SWINDLE: You know, I had him 5150'd in March I think...
20
21 MORENO: Of this year?
22
23 SWINDLE: Yeah.
24
25 MORENO: Was that here in Hemet?
26
27 SWINDLE: Um, from San Jacinto, from my house. My husband found him. He was gonna
28 kill himself. And, um, my husband found him at work. Like, we were chasing
29 him in the streets. I called the police. I asked 'em, I need help. I don't know what
30 else to do, my brother needs help. My husband got him to come to the house and
31 then I told him, "I'm gonna call the cops. Just tell 'em you need help. Don't
32 resist. Like, they're not - they'll - they'll be there to help you."
33
34 MORENO: Yeah.
35
36

1 SWINDLE: Like, we weren't raised that way but, like, he needs help.
2
3 MORENO: Yeah.
4
5 SWINDLE: So they 5150'd him. He went, I'll say five days maybe. He had been on
6 medication. He had got clean. But then it wasn't getting better and then they
7 separated July 5, he kicked her out. So she'd been staying at her mom's. I
8 haven't really seen her. (Unintelligible) it all kinda came to a head last week.
9 'Cause I told him, I'm like, you know, we grew up with no parents.
10
11 MORENO: Yeah.
12
13 SWINDLE: Our family's all we got. I just want to see my niece, you know? And my
14 brother's not seeing the kids. Like, I don't want this to be a thing. Like, my life is
15 different now but, like, you guys are gonna make me freak out. And I didn't
16 know it was Lalo...
17
18 MAN: Yeah.
19
20 SWINDLE: ...till last night. My brother called me right after.
21
22 MAN: He knew that she was steppin' out?
23
24 SWINDLE: Yeah.
25
26 MAN: You knew?
27
28 SWINDLE: No, I didn't.
29
30 MAN: Oh.
31
32 SWINDLE: Um, I knew - I found out probably a week ago, but we didn't know - he wouldn't
33 tell me who.
34
35 MAN: Okay.
36

2 MORENO: Okay.
3
4 SWINDLE: When I asked him who - I mean, because he, like, did a big huge Facebook post
5 and then called me. And I said, um, "What do you want me to do?" And he said,
6 "I don't want you to do anything. Like, you know, you got your life together."
7 You know, I got in trouble when I was young.
8
9 MORENO: Yeah.
10
11 SWINDLE: And then, um, he - I said, "Well who is the guy?" And he goes, "I don't care
12 enough to find out." I said, "Are you sure?" And he said, "Yeah," but he knew I
13 guess.
14
15 MORENO: Yeah.
16
17 MAN: Mm-hm.
18
19 SWINDLE: He told me last night. He's like, "I'm sorry I lied to you. I didn't want to tell you
20 'cause it was too close to home." I said, "All right, who is it?" And he said,
21 "Lalo." I mean, so her and him was at the park in the car. That's what he said.
22 Um, that he - he was like, "I just ran up on them." He was like, "They both saw
23 me. He looked at me." He's like, "I put two in his head. I told her, 'I love you.'"
24 And he was like, "And now I'm calling you." He's like, "I gotta..." He was
25 talking about killing himself and then I was like, "For what?" And he was goes,
26 "I can't go to jail." And I was like, "Dip then. Like, you don't have to kill
27 yourself. Then dip." Like, you know?
28
29 MORENO: Yeah.
30
31 SWINDLE: "You don't have to do this. You got a lot of kids, man." And, um, he, a - he was
32 like, "I just want to hug you one time." So I met with him. He gave me a hug. He
33 gave me...
34
35 MORENO: He went by your house or where?
36

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1
2 SWINDLE: No, I met him off of Park Hill on the - by the animals. He wouldn't go to my
3 house, my kids are there.
4
5 MORENO: Right - right.
6
7 SWINDLE: And then, ah, oh, thank you - thank you. And, um, thank you.
8
9 MORENO: I'm...
10
11 MAN: (Unintelligible).
12
13 MORENO: I'm good right now.
14
15 SWINDLE: He said, um...
16
17 MAN: (Unintelligible).
18
19 SWINDLE: He just gave me, um, a paper, like, written out. You know, like, everything goes
20 to my sister.
21
22 MAN: Oh, like a will?
23
24 MORENO: Like...
25
26 SWINDLE: Yeah.
27
28 MORENO: A last testament or...
29
30 SWINDLE: My sister has, um, access to my apartment. That's it. Or, like, my son can have
31 my c- my son can have his car. Um, but I don't know, um, like - like, what to tell
32 his kids, just kinda that. And then my husband went to, like - my husband was
33 like, "Give me the gun." And then he, um, he was like, "All right, yeah, it's in
34 the trunk." And my husband's like, "All right." 'Cause he knows my husband -
35 you know, last time my husband had to beat him up to get the gun from him. So
36

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1 my husband went to grab - to go to the trunk and my brother took off. And then
2 he called, he was like, "I told you guys not to change my mind." And then he
3 left. And he was, ah, he was like, "All right, you're right. I'm not gonna do this."
4 He's like, "I'll just leave." And I said, "Okay, call me I guess."

5
6 MORENO: Mm-hm.

7
8 SWINDLE: Then he called me at, like, f- he text me at, like, 5:45, "I love you, are you
9 awake?" I said, "Yeah, what's up?" He said, um, "I need to get into my house."
10 And then, um, I said, "Where are you? Do you want to come to my house?" And
11 he said, "No." And I said, "I'll meet you." And he was like, "I know. I know
12 you'll always come where I'm at." He was like, "You don't have to keep
13 cleaning up after me." And, um, I said, "Just - let me just see you. Like, let me
14 just see you for a minute. Let's just talk. Like, it doesn't have to be like this."
15 And he was like, "All right, I'm on my way." He was like, ah, "I'll
16 (unintelligible) close so we can meet." I said, "Okay." He called back two
17 minutes later and was like, "Know that I love you." And I was like, "I love you
18 more." And he was like, "There's a cop on me." I was like, "Maybe it's
19 coincidence." He was like, "No." He's like, "There's two." And I was like,
20 "What are you gonna do, bro? Like, just go then. Just let them - you know, like,
21 we got you. We got the kids."

22
23 MORENO: Mm-hm.

24
25 SWINDLE: Um, he was like, "No, you know I can't go to jail. I wasn't made that way." And
26 then I said, "Well where are you?" He said, "Palm and Menlo." He was like, "I
27 want to stay on the phone with you, but I want to hear some jams too." And I
28 was like, "Yeah, I feel it." And I said, "I'm coming to you." And he was like,
29 "You don't have to." And I was like, "I know." He's like, "You always do." And
30 I was like, "You're not gonna be alone. Like, let them take you bro, I'll be right
31 there. I'll come. Like, that's it." I mean, and we drove. I mean, we were
32 following - the Facebook thing is how we found him. And we pulled up. We
33 were - the cops were still driving. So, I mean, that's it.

34
35 MORENO: Which - which - you guys were in the white truck?

36

2 SWINDLE: Yeah.
3
4 MORENO: And you're coming this way behind them?
5
6 SWINDLE: From over here, yeah.
7
8 MORENO: So you were behind all the police cars?
9
10 SWINDLE: Yeah, so they were following him. 'Cause they were going slow.
11
12 MORENO: Yeah.
13
14 SWINDLE: He was going slow. I never got - really saw him. There was just so many cops,
15 and they were going really slow. And then once they stopped and all kinda got
16 out, you know, like, there was, like, three here and they were, like...
17
18 MORENO: Mm-hm.
19
20 SWINDLE: ...kinda rushing towards the car a little. And when my husband went to turn, I
21 jumped out of the car. But I mean, the cop grabbed me. And I told him, I was
22 like, "I'll tell you everything you guys want to know about the shooting,
23 anything. Can I just see him. If you let him see me, he won't do this. If he sees
24 that I'm here, he won't do this. No one would let me see him. And then I don't
25 know what happened next. Somebody said they were performing CPR. I said,
26 "Can I see him? I'll answer whatever you want me to answer."
27
28 MORENO: Yeah - yeah.
29
30 SWINDLE: I just want to see him. Like, why the fuck's my brother gotta die on the street by
31 himself? Like, honestly.
32
33 MORENO: Yeah.
34
35 MAN: Sorry for your loss.
36

1
2 MORENO: Exactly. And we 100% appreciate your cooperation. You know, we're trying to
3 do the best we can to get your brother off the street.
4
5 SWINDLE: Yeah, well I just don't want - yeah, my brother in the street. And I just want
6 everyone to, like, know, like, he's not crazy. Like - like, her family is telling
7 everyone in town already that he was trying to kill her and he missed. He wasn't
8 trying to kill her because he doesn't want his kids to grow up without a mom.
9
10 MORENO: Yeah.
11
12 SWINDLE: If he wanted to kill her fucking could have, obviously. Like, you have a big ass
13 gun like that and you shoot one guy two times and you don't reach over and kill
14 her, come on.
15
16 MORENO: Yeah - yeah.
17
18 SWINDLE: The town's just going crazy. And then they're gonna say things that aren't true
19 about my brother.
20
21 MORENO: Okay. Now you said you had him 5150'd, so he wanted to kill himself in March.
22 What was the deal with that? Was it because of his...
23
24 MAN: March or July?
25
26 MORENO: You said March and then she ended up kicking him out in July, right?
27
28 SWINDLE: He kicked her out, yeah, in July. Because he said that's when, um, after he, um,
29 got out of 5150, I guess her son found text messages and told my brother.
30
31 MAN: How long was he in (unintelligible).
32
33 SWINDLE: Like five days. I had to beg them to hold him past the 72 hours...
34
35 MORENO: Now what was...
36

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2 SWINDLE: ...just to get the meds.
3
4 MAN: I'm sorry, but the - what was the...
5
6 MORENO: The circumstance behind it?
7
8 SWINDLE: (Unintelligible) issues just run in our family. I have a brother that's
9 schizophrenic.
10
11 MAN: Is he bipolar, schizo- what's - has he been diagnosed?
12
13 SWINDLE: Ah, depressed - it was depression. Mostly it was just depression.
14
15 MAN: Was he alcoholic or drug abuse?
16
17 SWINDLE: Yeah, both - he had both. I mean, but he was doing that to, like...
18
19 MORENO: Self-medicate.
20
21 SWINDLE: Like, self-medicate, yeah.
22
23 MORENO: What was his drug of choice?
24
25 SWINDLE: Oh man, I got him clean off of, um, oxy a couple - like, once or twice this year or
26 last year. I got him rehab for heroin. Um, and then - and then he started doing
27 heroin and speed. I mean, he drank. He had been drinking yesterday.
28
29 MAN: When did all this start? This type of behavior. He's your little brother, correct?
30
31 SWINDLE: Yeah.
32
33 MAN: So when did you start noticing that his...
34
35 SWINDLE: Oh, about two years now.
36

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MAN: He wasn't like that when he was a kid?

SWINDLE: He kinda - I mean, I think he always - like, I always had to pep talk him, you know? Like I always tell him - like, we always call my other brother - my other brother's, like, different than us. I'll tell him, like, he's not the same as us. Like, 'cause all of them grew up away from us.

MORENO: Mm-hm.

SWINDLE: Like, he's weak. Like, bro, you can get your mind right. Like, just shake it off.

MORENO: Excuse me.

SWINDLE: You know what I'm saying? And we grew up real rough. My dad died in front of us and stuff. And so I told him, I'm like, we'll just get your mind right.

MORENO: Yeah.

SWINDLE: Shake it off. And he would sometimes show up like, man, I can't shake it off. And, like, Monday night he picked me up and we just went for a drive.

MORENO: This was on this past Monday?

SWINDLE: Yeah.

MORENO: So prior to last night when you said he drove around then...

SWINDLE: I see him every day.

MORENO: Okay, you saw...

SWINDLE: I see him every day. I talk to him every day, like, I don't know how many times a day.

1 MORENO: Okay. Now besides back in March when you said you had him 5150, is there any
2 - any suicidal tenancies or any thoughts that he might have told you prior to that?
3
4 SWINDLE: Mm-mm. She found a letter one time, but then when I asked him about it, he was
5 like, "It's just my thoughts." He was like, "You told me I had to get my mind
6 right." He's like, "So I'm just journaling."
7
8 MORENO: Yeah.
9
10 SWINDLE: And so I was like, "All right, like, but you tell me if it gets too much and then I'll
11 help you." You know what I'm saying??
12
13 MORENO: Mm-hm.
14
15 MAN: Mm-hm.
16
17 SWINDLE: I mean, he held down two jobs. He worked for the school.
18
19 MORENO: Oh wow.
20
21 SWINDLE: Yeah, he worked for, um, what's - Monte Vista, I think that school is.
22
23 MORENO: What was his position there?
24
25 SWINDLE: He was security. Like, one of the heads of security.
26
27 MORENO: Hm.
28
29 SWINDLE: He does security at night too. He worked two jobs for years.
30
31 MORENO: Okay.
32
33 SWINDLE: I mean, he was, like, super high functioning...
34
35 MORENO: Yeah.
36

2 SWINDLE: ...like, with addiction and stuff. I think it was the stuff with her, dude.
3
4 MORENO: Yeah.
5
6 SWINDLE: It really sent him over the edge. I mean, 'cause he's never been violent. Like, his
7 demeanor's always been, like, calm. Like, he's always, like, level headed. Like,
8 when I feel like I'm freaking out I always call him like, "Bro, tell me, am I being
9 dramatic?" 'Cause I flip out. And he'd always, like, calm me down. So when he
10 called last night - I mean, but even the story was very calm. He's like, "Yeah,
11 this shit with Nivia has been weird." And I was like, "Yeah, I know." He was
12 like, "Did you eat?" I said, "Yeah, you want to come eat?" 'Cause he's been
13 coming to eat at the house since she's been gone.
14
15 MORENO: Mm-hm.
16
17 SWINDLE: And he was - I said, "Or do you want to go get something to eat?" He's like,
18 "Not if you're in bed." I was like, "No, I'll get up." He was like, "Well where's
19 Ed?" My husband, he's real close to my husband. We've been together since my
20 brother was 16. I said, "He's right here." He said, "Put me on speaker, yeah?"
21 And I was like, "Dro, what's happening?" I thought he was gonna say he was
22 gonna kill himself again or something.
23
24 MORENO: Yeah.
25
26 SWINDLE: And he was like, "I'm sorry I lied to you." And I said "About what?" And he
27 said, "When you asked me who she was fuckin' around with, I told you I didn't
28 know." And I said, "But you do?" And he was like, "It's too close to home and I
29 didn't need you to do something." He was like, ah, he's like, "(Unintelligible)
30 cleaning up my messes." He was like, "I need to handle my shit myself." I said,
31 "Who is it?" And he said, "Lalo." I said, "Okay, what do you want - want to do?"
32 He goes, "I already put two in his head." And that's why I was like, "Wait,
33 what?" That's when my husband looked at me and he was like, "Get up. Like,
34 get up." And so I was like, "Wait, what the fuck did you say to me right now?"
35 And he was like, "Dog, I put two in his fuckin' head." And he was like, "And I
36

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1 feel better. Like, I feel..." He's like, "I feel at peace. I feel content." And I was
2 like, "Where's Nivia?" He's like, "She was there." And he was like, "I don't
3 want to hurt her. I don't want to hurt my kids, but he was my friend." I mean,
4 that was - he only had, like, three friends.
5
6 MORENO: Hm.
7
8 SWINDLE: And that was one of - one of them.
9
10 MORENO: Mm-hm. Roughly about what time did you get this call from him?
11
12 SWINDLE: I can look. Probably 9:00. It was directly after.
13
14 MORENO: Mm-hm.
15
16 SWINDLE: Like, he had just drove from there.
17
18 MORENO: Okay.
19
20 MAN: And he told you it happened at the park and everything?
21
22 SWINDLE: Yeah. 'Cause I said, "Where are you?" He was like, "No, I already dipped from
23 there." And I said, "From where?" And I was like, "Where the fuck are the
24 kids?" And he was like, "No, I already saw the kids." He's like, "I called my
25 son." So I texted my nephew, but he didn't say anything to my nephew besides,
26 "I'm gonna go for a drive and clear my head."
27
28 MORENO: Mm-hm.
29
30 SWINDLE: I texted my nephew, "Are you okay?" He said, "Yeah." I said, "Have you talked
31 to your dad?" He said, "Yeah." I said, "Where's your sister and your mom?"
32 'Cause I'm like no, did he really do this? Or - he said, "I don't know where my
33 mom is. My sister's at my grandma's." And so then I called my brother back and
34 I was like, "Dude, what - what the fuck?" He was like, "I just feel better now,
35 like, honestly."
36

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1
2 MAN: Hm.
3
4 SWINDLE: Once he...
5
6 MORENO: And then after that he - he - he was calling and texting you throughout the night?
7
8 SWINDLE: Yeah.
9
10 MAN: T- what - what kind of gun did he have?
11
12 SWINDLE: Ah, I think it was a 357, 'cause the sho...
13
14 MAN: Revo- like a revo...
15
16 SWINDLE: Yeah.
17
18 MAN: You - you know the difference between a...
19
20 SWINDLE: Yeah.
21
22 MAN: ...revolver and a...
23
24 SWINDLE: I think it was a revolver.
25
26 MAN: Okay.
27
28 SWINDLE: Um, I'm pretty sure it was like, um, you know, like, a black handle, silver barrel.
29
30 MAN: You said that he - he - you guys took the gun away from him? Was that the same
31 gun?
32
33 MORENO: The same gun?
34
35 SWINDLE: No, different.
36

1
2 MAN: Oh.
3
4 SWINDLE: When we had him 5150'd he had a shotgun.
5
6 MAN: Oh, okay.
7
8 SWINDLE: A loaded shotgun and my husband got it from him.
9
10 MAN: Okay.
11
12 SWINDLE: And then I gave it to the police when I called them to 5150 them.
13
14 MORENO: And that was, ah, the Sheriff's Department from...
15
16 SWINDLE: Yes.
17
18 MORENO: ...San Jacinto?
19
20 SWINDLE: Yeah, they came to my house. And they came up - they just were trying to get
21 him. And I was like, ah, they were like, "Where's the gun?" They thought it was
22 in his car. And I was like, "No, my husband..." They're like, "What happened to
23 his face?" I was like, "My husband socked him up and took the gun from him."
24
25 MORENO: Ah.
26
27 SWINDLE: And they took, like, the - a suicide letter then. They had all that. I have never
28 gotten none of it back.
29
30 MORENO: Okay. That was March of this year, correct?
31
32 SWINDLE: Yeah, I think it was March I'm pretty sure. Let's see. He called at, ah, 9:35 was
33 the first call, yeah, yesterday. Like, 'cause I talked to him before that, just
34 texting. But it was like...
35
36

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1 MORENO: Right. And when he was released from mental health in March, was he given any
2 mental or, ah, psychiatric medication?
3
4 SWINDLE: Mm-hm, and he took it for awhile.
5
6 MORENO: When was - when did he stop taking it?
7
8 SWINDLE: Um, you know, I asked her and she said he stopped taking it because it was
9 making him, like, um, like, have ED.
10
11 MAN: Like have what?
12
13 SWINDLE: Like - like, erectile dysfunction.
14
15 MAN: Oh, ED.
16
17 MORENO: Oh.
18
19 SWINDLE: Yeah. And, um, she was, like, not happy about it.
20
21 MAN: Hm.
22
23 SWINDLE: So he stopped taking it.
24
25 MAN: Hm.
26
27 SWINDLE: I don't know, like, the exact time. I would have to, like, piece it together, like,
28 what they would tell me, you know?
29
30 MAN: Do you remember the type of medication it was?
31
32 SWINDLE: Oh, um, it was Paxil. Um, and then they had him on Suboxone to take away the -
33 you know, for the, um, drugs. I don't remember the other one, I'd have to look.
34
35 MORENO: And - and...
36

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1
2 SWINDLE: I have it all written down somewhere.
3
4 MORENO: And had - had you seen him with this 357 before?
5
6 SWINDLE: Um, once I saw it at the house but that was it.
7
8 MORENO: At their house?
9
10 SWINDLE: Yeah.
11
12 MORENO: Him and Nivia's house?
13
14 SWINDLE: Mm-hm - no, she - after she had moved out.
15
16 MORENO: After she had moved out.
17
18 SWINDLE: Yeah, only 'cause I had took a bed over there and I asked him, I was like,
19 "Whose is that?" And he was like, "Oh, my homeboy's." I was like, "What
20 homeboy?" And he was like, "Don't trip - don't trip." And I was like, "Bro, like,
21 what the fuck's going on?" He was like, "No, I'm good." I was like, "Are you
22 good?" And he was like, "Yeah." I said, "All right, well you need to tell me, like,
23 what you need me to do." And he was like, "No, I'm good." He was like, "I'm
24 getting rid of it for him." I was like, "All right."
25
26 MAN: Now was he - as a security guard, was he an armed security guard?
27
28 SWINDLE: No.
29
30 MAN: I know he probably couldn't be with a 5150, ah...
31
32 MORENO: Right.
33
34 SWINDLE: That just happened. He's been a security guard forever. But now, he has a guard
35 card but I don't think it's armed, no.
36

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1
2 MORENO: Okay. Where was - what - do you remember which, ah, security...
3
4 SWINDLE: The new...
5
6 MORENO: ...company he was working for?
7
8 SWINDLE: I have it written down but the newest one he's doing, um, Home Depot in
9 Temecula he does during the day.
10
11 MORENO: Oh, like, loss prevention stuff?
12
13 SWINDLE: No, like, they're outside.
14
15 MORENO: Outside? Oh.
16
17 SWINDLE: They have him outside, like, yeah. Like, how we all have here in town. So...
18
19 MORENO: Hm.
20
21 SWINDLE: And then he's been - he's been fighting with the school because they were trying
22 to not let him come back after he 5150'd.
23
24 MORENO: Yeah.
25
26 MAN: Hm.
27
28 SWINDLE: So - because he works with kids, and - but they can't really fire him, so he's been
29 fighting that for a long time. That's been pretty, like, rough, like, he's been going
30 through it over that. I think so that, and then, I mean - I mean, she dipped with
31 his best friend.
32
33 MAN: This is - let me interrupt, this is Detective Williamson.
34
35 SWINDLE: Yeah, I know.
36

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1
2 MAN: He's kinda like the - you talked to him already with the - I'm not sure if you
3 talked to him already.
4
5 SWINDLE: Mmm, kinda.
6
7 MAN: Talkin' about la- the shit that went down with Lalo.
8
9 ((CROSSTALK))
10
11 MAN: So that's what he's looking into.
12
13 SWINDLE: Oh, okay, (unintelligible).
14
15 MORENO: Now just so I - maybe I...
16
17 SWINDLE: That doesn't matter now.
18
19 MORENO: You might have said it, but I might not have caught it. While you were talking to
20 him after - after he told - he called you at 9:30, up until when this happened, did
21 he tell you he was - he was gonna kill himself?
22
23 SWINDLE: Mmm...
24
25 MORENO: Or did he just say he wasn't going back to jail?
26
27 SWINDLE: He just eluded to it. He was - he'd never been to jail. He just eluded to it.
28
29 MORENO: Okay.
30
31 SWINDLE: Like, I said - when I called him I was like, "Where are you?" He was like, "I had
32 to come home." And I was like, "Why did you come back? Bro, I thought you
33 were leaving." He was like, "No, you wanted me to leave, I'm not going to jail."
34 And, um, he was like, I was - he goes, "I don't want the same as you." He's like,
35 "I wasn't built for that." Like, and so I was like, "Okay, but you don't have to do
36

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1 anything." He was like, "Yeah." He was like, "Well..." He goes, "I guess we'll
2 see how this plays out." He wanted the cops to kill him. So, I mean, that was
3 pretty clear. I guess he talked to my son. My son called him too when he was
4 driving last night 'cause he was just driving around.

5
6 MORENO: Mm-hm.

7
8 SWINDLE: Like, he called and was in Riverside. And I was like, "What are you doing?"
9 'Cause he was posting on Facebook. I'm like, "Bro, quit posting on Facebook."
10 He was like, "It's funny." And I'm like, "It's not fuckin' funny."

11
12 MORENO: Your brother was posting...

13
14 SWINDLE: Yeah.

15
16 MORENO: ...stuff on Facebook.

17
18 SWINDLE: Just, like, songs.

19
20 MORENO: Oh.

21
22 SWINDLE: And, like, a selfie.

23
24 MORENO: With the gun?

25
26 SWINDLE: No.

27
28 MORENO: Oh.

29
30 SWINDLE: Just...

31
32 MORENO: So he's...

33
34 SWINDLE: ...to poke everyone, like, I don't know.

35
36

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1 MAN: On Facebook, did he put - say anything about Lalo?
2
3 SWINDLE: Um, no. He never said Lalo's name on Facebook. I mean, he just put this big
4 long thing the other day about how she cheated on him. But he tried to stay for
5 the kids. They had been trying - they had been trying to work it out. I mean, I
6 hadn't seen her until last week, like I told you, when I went and told 'em I
7 needed to see my niece. And she just cried and she just said, um, she's like, "I
8 don't know." You know, she's like, "Look where I'm living." And I was like,
9 "Well, you fuckin' did this." Like, it's my brother, I'm not getting in it. As long
10 as no one keeps the kids from me, it's not - there's no problem.
11
12 MAN: Yeah.
13
14 SWINDLE: You keep the kids from me, it's gonna be a fuckin' problem, I don't care.
15
16 MORENO: Now do they have kids together or from a prior relationship?
17
18 SWINDLE: She has one that's from a prior, and then another one with my brother.
19
20 MORENO: So the oldest...
21
22 SWINDLE: So my brother's raised the boy.
23
24 MORENO: The - the son is - your brother raised him as his own child.
25
26 SWINDLE: Yeah.
27
28 MORENO: Okay. And they...
29
30 SWINDLE: And he calls my brother his dad.
31
32 MORENO: And they have a biological daughter together?
33
34 SWINDLE: Yeah.
35
36

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1 MORENO: Okay. And they're with her?
2
3 SWINDLE: They're with her, yeah.
4
5 MORENO: Okay.
6
7 SWINDLE: At her mom's house. I mean, because her mom called me last night. Her dad
8 called my brother when he was driving last night too. And then her mom called
9 this morning. I talked to Nivia this morning. And then the only - like, it's been
10 fine, but the only problem...
11
12 MORENO: What did Nivia tell you this morning?
13
14 SWINDLE: Um...
15
16 MORENO: Did she tell you what happened at the park?
17
18 SWINDLE: Well, I, um, I actually had called her mom. I'm upset, you know? So I said, um,
19 when her mom called back I said, "Can I talk to Nivia?" She's like, "Don't call
20 yelling." And I was like, "Lookit, I'm not fucking yelling. Just let me talk to
21 Nivia." This isn't - and her mom has nothing to do with this.
22
23 MAN: Yeah - yeah - yeah.
24
25 SWINDLE: And then her mom would, like, run her. So when Nivia got on the phone, she
26 would - she just said hello and I told her - I'm like, "Why the fuck did you do
27 this? Like, two fuckin' people are dead 'cause of you. Honestly, like, on some
28 real shit, you're sloppy. And now - and then you just want to be in the streets
29 with this motherfucker and my brother's dead in the street by himself and you're
30 just asleep at home?" And she was like, "I understand." "You fucking
31 understand?" I was like, "You called the cops on my brother." And she was like,
32 "No I didn't." I was like, "On Facebook it says you fuckin' called 911." She
33 goes, "What was I supposed to do? Your brother shot Lalo." Or, "He shot Lalo,"
34 is what she said. "He shot Lalo." And she goes, "What?" And he's - she was like,
35 "He was bleeding everywhere. I'm supposed to push him out of the car and
36

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1 leave?" I said, "You told the cops - why were the cops at my sister's house up in
2 Hesperia?" I said, "You told 'em where my sister live. Like, you're dragging my
3 whole family into this when you done this?" And she was like, "No, I promise."
4 And I was like, "Lookit, I don't give a fuck about anything except for my brother
5 and the kids." I was like, "Nivia, don't fucking keep the kids from me. That's all
6 I got." And she was like, "I know, I would never." And I was like, "And tell your
7 family to stay the fuck away from me 'cause your brother's running his mouth
8 already." Her brother called my brother-in-law and said, you know, you're fu-
9 ah, Dro - we call him Dro. Ah, "Dro really was - was trying to kill fucking Nivia
10 and missed and shot Lalo." No the fuck he didn't. He did what he wanted to do.
11 If he wanted to kill Nivia, he had every opportunity. They're there in the dark,
12 like, all off on a dead end. But - and so - so I called her brother too, I don't care.
13 "(Unintelligible) you need to quit talking about my brother." He said, "The cops
14 said your brother was trying to kill Nivia." And I was like, "No the fuck they
15 didn't 'cause the cops have been waiting to talk to me all morning. They don't
16 know."

17
18 MORENO: Mm-hm.

19
20 SWINDLE: And he wanted - I was like, "It's common sense. You guys don't, like, have
21 sense. If he wanted to kill her, he would have."

22
23 MORENO: Yeah.

24
25 SWINDLE: He doesn't want the kids to have no mom. And Lalo was my friend. That's what
26 my brother kept telling me. He's like, "This ain't over a girl. It's over, he was my
27 friend and this is my family." And I was like, "I get it." He was like - I mean, he
28 wrote that on the paper. He's like, "Just so everyone knows this ain't over no
29 pussy." Okay, got it. I mean, it's pretty, like, cut and dry. Nivia's mom, when she
30 called last night, said Nivia went to give Lalo a ride. Like, 'cause they're - 'cause
31 they're naive and they don't want to admit that their daughter (unintelligible)
32 fucking like she's 15 on the side of the road. I don't know. (Unintelligible)
33 'cause she called me. She goes, um, they - she goes, "We think Ysidro shot
34 Lalo." I said, "Why do you think that?" She said, um, "Lalo and Ysidro was at
35 the park." And I said, "That's weird. That doesn't make sense to me." And she
36

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1 goes, "Well Nivia was there too." I said, "Okay, so Nivia was there, Ysidro was
2 there, Lalo was there, but you're saying my brother shot him. Why?" She goes,
3 "Well Nivia went to give him a ride and we hadn't heard from her, so I guess she
4 was with him for a long time before this.
5
6 MORENO: Mm-hm.
7
8 SWINDLE: And my brother followed them.
9
10 MAN: Hm.
11
12 SWINDLE: But my brother told me he'd been following them. That he had been planning it,
13 is what he said last night when he was driving.
14
15 MORENO: His - so he kinda made it seem to you like he had been wanting to get it together
16 or what?
17
18 SWINDLE: Ah, he just wanted to see for his own eyes and get Lalo.
19
20 MAN: Did he ever catch 'em together?
21
22 MORENO: Or...
23
24 SWINDLE: No, last night was the first time. (Unintelligible) wasn't supposed to happen like
25 this, this fast, this soon. And I was like, "So what happened?" He was like, "Bro,
26 he was, like, on top of her, making out with her." Like, um, he was like, "Like,
27 they were going at in the car." And he goes, "And then I walked up and tapped
28 the window, is when he, like, moved off of her." 'Cause he was on top of her. He
29 moved off of her. And then he said he just shot him. He goes, "I don't know if
30 the second one hit him, but the first one did." And then I said, "Now where the
31 fuck is Nivia?" And he goes, "I looked in her eye and told her, 'Love you, bye.'"
32 And so I was like, "What the fuck have you done?" And he was like, "I feel
33 better." So he goes, "I haven't felt, like, peace in a long time."
34
35 MAN: When did he tell you that he - he knew about it. I think - I think you said it, but I
36

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1 just want to confirm. When did he tell you that he found out about Lalo and
2 Nivia?
3
4 SWINDLE: Ah, about a week ago he said that he found out she was cheating on him.
5
6 MAN: Okay.
7
8 SWINDLE: He kinda told the whole - he put it on Facebook, like, this big huge thing. And
9 then I called him. I was like, blowing him up and blowing him up. And then he
10 was like, "I'll call you in a little bit, I'm with my daughter." So he called and, ah,
11 that's when I asked him. And he said he didn't know. But last night he told me -
12 'cause I asked him, I said, "Who the fuck is it? What do you want to do?" Like,
13 "You want me to beat this bitch's ass, I'll do it. Whatever you want me to do,
14 I'm gonna do it right now. Like, this is our family." And he was like, "No, it's
15 not about her." And I said, "Okay, who's the guy?" And goes, "I don't care
16 enough to find out." I said, "Are you sure?" And he goes, "Yeah, leave it at that.
17 Just leave it alone." He was like, "You don't need to clean up my mess." I said,
18 "All right. If you change your mind, you let me know." That was it. That was...
19
20 MAN: Two weeks ago?
21
22 SWINDLE: No, probably t- Tuesday.
23
24 MAN: Tuesday of this week?
25
26 MORENO: This week?
27
28 SWINDLE: Yeah, it was all this week, yeah. Yeah, 'cause Monday night he picked me up. So
29 it had to have been Tuesday. 'Cause were all, like, having back to back, like, just
30 bad days. And then - so, like, Tuesday, so...
31
32 MAN: That's when he posted on Facebook, that big thing?
33
34 SWINDLE: Yeah.
35
36

1 MAN: On Tuesday?
2
3 SWINDLE: Yeah. So then last night when I said - when he called, he said it first. He was
4 like, "I'm sorry I lied to you." I said, "About what?" And he was like, "I knew
5 who it was the whole time." And he was like, "Israel put me on a game." Like,
6 um, his son.
7
8 MAN: His son?
9
10 SWINDLE: Yeah, the son, the one that found out that mom was cheating, um, found out who
11 it was told him.
12
13 MAN: Hm.
14
15 SWINDLE: And...
16
17 MAN: How old's his son?
18
19 SWINDLE: Ah, 13. He texted me, like - he would text - he texted me all the time, my
20 brother, even since they left 'cause she has a drinking problem, like, and leaves
21 the kids and stuff. So I guess the night I went over there it was, like, a big issue
22 and he went through her phone 'cause she got drunk and, like, passed out.
23
24 MAN: Oh.
25
26 SWINDLE: And, um, her dad hit her. She tried to leave in the car and stuff. And when she
27 passed out, I guess Israel went through her phone and found out who exactly it
28 was and then told my brother it was Lalo. And then my brother told me last
29 night. He was like, "I couldn't tell you because I know that you would react."
30 And he was like, "I just needed to, like, handle it myself and think it through."
31 And he was like, "I've been..." He was like, "I peeped, like, the whole schedule.
32 What time every one leaves. So..." I mean, he put a GPS on the car, so...
33
34 MAN: He was following Nivia?
35
36

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1 SWINDLE: Yeah. There's a tracker on the car. Not the one that's built in. It's a store bought
2 one too, yeah. He just said this all last night. So - so I mean, I don't know what
3 else to say at that point.
4
5 MORENO: Yeah.
6
7 SWINDLE: At that point I just wanted to see my brother. I'm like, I'd rather he live in prison
8 than fuckin' die like this, but...
9
10 MORENO: Yeah.
11
12 SWINDLE: This is how he wanted it. I mean, that's why I told them when I first came up in
13 the morning, I was like, "He wants you guys to kill him. If I could just move
14 down and he sees me, he's not gonna do this." Like how he wouldn't come to my
15 house 'cause my kids are there. Like, he has respect.
16
17 MORENO: Yeah.
18
19 SWINDLE: (Unintelligible) himself, you know? I mean, even today he still - even in the
20 morning, he was like, "Listen." He was like, "Listen." I mean, he's like, "You're
21 gonna be mad." He's like, "Just leave her alone. Just leave her be, like, the kids,
22 you know?"
23
24 MORENO: Hm.
25
26 MAN: Now his car's got some front dam- damage. Right front damage.
27
28 SWINDLE: Oh, somebody knocked into him, like, two weeks ago.
29
30 MAN: Oh, okay.
31
32 SWINDLE: And they did a hit and run actually. He filed a report.
33
34 MAN: Oh, he did?
35
36

1 SWINDLE: Yeah.
2
3 MAN: Okay. Here - here in the city?
4
5 SWINDLE: Yeah.
6
7 MAN: Or in San Jacinto?
8
9 SWINDLE: Um, I think it was in San Jacinto. I don't remember what gas station it was at. He
10 was getting - going to get gas and they hit him. And they were, like, locked on
11 and they pulled off. And when he got out to go get their info they took off. I
12 think it was the Fast Trip 'cause he asked the owner for the, um, tapes and stuff.
13 And he called the police.
14
15 MAN: Fas- a gas station called Fast Trip?
16
17 SWINDLE: Yeah, it's on 7th right there.
18
19 MAN: Okay.
20
21 SWINDLE: Yeah, that was from that.
22
23 MAN: Is that in San Jacinto or in the City of Hemet?
24
25 SWINDLE: That's San Jacinto, yeah.
26
27 MAN: Okay, so (unintelligible) would have taken that report.
28
29 SWINDLE: Yeah, that was from the accident, someone hit him. He just bought that car. He
30 hasn't had it that long.
31
32 MAN: Okay. And, ah, and we know that you walked up to see your brother. I saw that
33 that happened. It shouldn't have happened. But did you take - move anything or
34 take anything. No, just pulled the cover off. We just moved the long...
35
36

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1 MAN: Who was with you?
2
3 SWINDLE: The cover. My si- my sister.
4
5 MAN: Okay.
6
7 SWINDLE: That was her running off.
8
9 MAN: Okay.
10
11 SWINDLE: I was behind her.
12
13 MAN: Okay.
14
15 SWINDLE: No, all we pulled up was along the cover line. Why, was something missing?
16
17 MAN: No - no - no, just have to ask.
18
19 SWINDLE: No - no - no. We just wanted to see him, like...
20
21 MAN: Right.
22
23 SWINDLE: I can't absorb it, you know what I'm saying? Like, I see someone in the street
24 but, like, is it my brother?
25
26 MAN: Okay.
27
28 MORENO: I don't have any questions.
29
30 MAN: I don't have any.
31
32 MORENO: Do you have any questions for us?
33
34 SWINDLE: No, I just want my brother's (unintelligible).
35
36

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1 MAN: We're, ah, we're processing the scene.
2
3 MORENO: Processing the scene.
4
5 MAN: We're trying to get it done as fast as we can.
6
7 SWINDLE: (Unintelligible) the coroner, and I'm gonna go to...
