SUBJECT: AUTOPSY PROTOCOL

An autopsy was performed on the body of Demilo Trayvon Hodge at the Coroner's Bureau, 2901 Peralta Oaks Court, Oakland, California, on September 28, 2017, at about 9:00 a.m.

FINDINGS

- 1) MULTIPLE (OVER 22) GUNSHOT WOUNDS
  - A. INJURIES TO BRAIN, SKULL, LUNGS, AORTA, VENA CAVA, LIVER, AND HUMERUS
  - B. MULTIPLE BULLETS AND BULLET FRAGMENTS RECOVERED
  - C. INTERNAL HEMORRHAGE.
- 2) MINOR EXTERNAL INJURIES TO HEAD, NECK, TORSO, AND LIMBS.
- 3) OLD GUNSHOT WOUND TO RIGHT LEG.
- 4) PLEASE SEE SEPARATE TOXICOLOGY REPORT (CVT-17-9827).

CAUSE OF DEATH: MULTIPLE GUNSHOT WOUNDS.

1                                    CIRCUMSTANCES OF DEATH

2            This 45 year-old gentleman was in a vehicle being chased by  
3 police. Eventually his vehicle was disabled and stopped. He  
4 got out of the vehicle and discharged a handgun once before  
5 being shot multiple times by police. He was pronounced dead at  
6 hospital.

7                                    PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION

8            The unembalmed body of a middle-aged man is on a mortuary  
9 table, is undressed, and has a properly labeled identification  
10 tag. Multiple gunshot wounds are seen. Evidence of medical-  
11 [REDACTED] is seen. Paper bags are on the hands. The  
12 fingernails are intact and very short. Gunpowder residue samples  
13 and fingernail clippings are taken.

14                                   RECENT INJURIES

15           No gunpowder soot or stippling is seen on the skin around  
16 any of the wounds. No clothing is available for examination.

17           Penetrating and perforating gunshot wounds to the forehead

18           Entrance wounds: On the upper forehead are three entry  
19 wound. One of these located 1-1/4 inches below the top of the  
20 head and 1-1/4 inches right of a sagittal midline is 1/8 inch,  
21 is roughly round, and has a 1/16 inch rim of red-brown abrasion.  
22 Another of these wounds located 1-1/2 inches below the top of

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23 the head and along a sagittal midline is 3/16 inch, is roughly  
24 round, and has a 1/16 to 1/8 inch rim of red-brown abrasion. The  
25 last of these wounds located 1-1/2 inches below the top of the  
26 head and 1-3/8 inches left of a sagittal midline is 1/8 inch, is  
27 roughly round, and has a 1/16 to 1/8 inch rim of red-brown  
28 abrasion widest of the 6 to 9 o'clock margin.

29       Pathway: The wounds extend through the hemorrhagic soft  
30 tissue of the scalp and through a large defect surrounded by  
31 comminuted bone fragments of the frontal bones. The track  
32 continues through the hemorrhagic markedly lacerated brain  
33 including through the region of the midbrain and pons. The  
34 track passes through a large defect in the comminuted bones at  
35 the posterior base of the skull.

36       Extensive fractures radiate through the entire skull giving  
37 it a broken eggshell-like appearance. The track passes through  
38 the hemorrhagic muscle and soft tissue at the back of the neck  
39 without appreciable injuries to the cervical vertebrae.

40       Exit wound: On the back of the neck located about 8-1-2  
41 inches below the top of the head and 1-1/2 inches right of a  
42 sagittal midline is a gaping-open, irregular-shaped, 1-1/2 x 1  
43 inch wound.

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44 Projectile: Recovered near the brain stem is a deformed,  
45 copper-colored jacketed, small to medium-sized bullet.  
46 Recovered along the track in the brain are several pieces of  
47 copper-color jacket, including the base to a small-sized bullet.

48 Trajectory: The trajectories are front to back and  
49 downward. As a group they are also slightly left to right.

50 Penetrating gunshot wound to right cheek

51 Entrance wound: On the medial right cheek located about 5-  
52 1/2 inches below the top of the head and 1-1/4 inches right of  
53 an anterior sagittal midline is a 1/2 x 1/4 inch wound with a  
54 1/16 to 3/8 inch rim of red-brown abrasion widest along the 6 yo  
55 9 o'clock margin.

56 Pathway: The track extends through the hemorrhagic muscle  
57 and soft tissue fragmenting the right cheek bones. The track  
58 passes through the clivus region and through the brainstem. The  
59 track exits the skull through the large defect in the comminuted  
60 posterior skull.

61 Projectile: Recovered in the occipital scalp is a large-  
62 sized, deformed, copper-colored jacketed, grey metal bullet as  
63 well as a small copper-color jacket fragment.

64 Trajectory: The track extends front to back and minimally  
65 right to left.

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66                   Perforating gunshot wound to left lower abdomen

67           Entrance wound: On the left lower quadrant of the abdomen  
68   located about 36 inches above the heels and 1-3/4 inches left of  
69   an anterior sagittal midline is a roughly oval 1/2 x 5/16 inch  
70   wound with a 1/16 rim of red-brown abrasion.

71           Pathway: The track extends through the slightly hemorrhagic  
72   fat without entering the abdominal cavity.

73           Exit wound: In the right upper quadrant of the abdomen  
74   located about 40 inches above the heels and 5 inches right of an  
75   anterior sagittal midline is a 1 inch, roughly round wound with  
76   a patchy up to 1/8 inch of red-brown abrasion and dying.

77           Trajectory: The track extends left to right and slightly  
78   upward.

79                   Perforating gunshot wound to right upper abdomen

80           Entrance wound: On the right upper quadrant located about  
81   51-1/2 inches above the heel and 2 inches right of the anterior  
82   sagittal midline is about 3/16 inch, roughly round wound with a  
83   1/16 to 1/4 inch rim of red-brown abrasion widest along its  
84   superior margin.

85           Pathway: The track extends through the hemorrhagic fat  
86   without entering the abdominal cavity.

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87 Exit wound: Along the lateral right lower quadrant of the  
88 abdomen centered about 38 inches above the heels and 5 inches  
89 right an anterior sagittal midline is a 2 x 1 inch graze-type  
90 wound that has a roughly 12:30 to 6:30 orientation of its long  
91 axis and has patchy up to 1/8 inch red-brown abrasion along its  
92 edges.

93 Trajectory: The track extends downward and minimally left  
94 to right.

95 Penetrating gunshot wound to upper lateral right thigh

96 Entrance wound: On the lateral right buttock located about  
97 39-1/2 inches above the heels and 4 inches behind a coronal  
98 midline is a 3/16 inch, roughly round wound with a 1/16 inch rim  
99 of red-brown abrasion.

100 Pathway: The track extends through the hemorrhagic muscle  
101 and soft tissue of the pelvic area resulting in a very slight  
102 notching of the upper edge of the right ilium. The track passes  
103 though the pelvic area injuring loops of small bowel. The track  
104 passes into the left thigh area.

105 Projectile: Located beneath a faint 1 inch blue contusion  
106 in the proximal anterior-lateral left thigh is a copper-colored  
107 jacketed, small to medium, very slightly deformed bullet.

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108       Trajectory: The track extends right to left, very slightly  
109 back to front, and minimally downward.

110               Perforating gunshot wound to left shoulder

111       Entrance wound: On the top and front of the left shoulder  
112 located about 11-3/4 inches below the top of the head and 9  
113 inches left of an anterior sagittal midline is a roughly round  
114 3/6 inch diameter, wound with a 1/16 to 1/4 inch rim of red-  
115 brown abrasion widest at the 8 to 9 o'clock margin.

116       Pathway: The track extends through the hemorrhagic muscle  
117 and soft tissue of the shoulder without involving the underlying  
118 bone or joint cavity.

119       Exit wound: On the side of the left shoulder located about  
120 11-1/2 inches below the top of the head and 11 inches of a  
121 sagittal midline is a gaping-open, 3-1/4 x, 2 inch wound with an  
122 irregular-shaped rim of red-brown abrasion up to 1/2 inch wide.

123       Trajectory: The track is right to left and front to back.

124               Cul-de-sac gunshot wound to right clavicle area

125       Entrance wound: On the top of the medial right shoulder is  
126 a 1-1/2 x 1 inch, irregular-shaped wound with patchy red-brown  
127 abrasion around it.

128       Pathway: The wound extends for about 1 inch in depth into  
129 the slightly hemorrhagic soft tissues.



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130        Projectile: A copper-color jacket fragment is recovered  
131 embedded near the clavicle at the case of the cul-de-sac.

132        Trajectory: The track extends primarily downward.

133                Penetrating gunshot wound to right lower chest

134        Entrance wound: On the right lower chest about 15 inches  
135 below the top of the head and 2 inches right of an anterior  
136 midline is an about 1/8 to 3/16 inch round wound with a 1/16 to  
137 1/8 inch rim of r-rbl abrasion.

138        Pathway: The track passes through the hemorrhagic chest  
139 wall, enters the mediastinum, and transections the pulmonary  
140 artery and aorta just after they leave the heart.

141        Projectile: Recovered free in the chest cavity is a small  
142 to medium-sized copper-colored jacketed bullet.

143        Trajectory: The track extends upward, slightly front to  
144 back, and very slightly right to left.

145                Penetrating gunshot wound to right arm and chest

146        Entrance wound: On the inside of the right upper arm about  
147 19 inches from the tip of the longest finger and 1 inch behind a  
148 coronal midline is a 3/8 x 3/16 oval wound.

149        Pathway: The track extends through the upper arm fracturing  
150 the humerus. On the back of the right upper arm is a 1/2 x 1/4  
151 inch irregular-shaped wound (This may be a defect through which

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152 a bullet fragment or piece of bone exited.). The track passes  
153 out of the arm in the armpit area as 1/2 x 1 inch irregular-  
154 shaped defect. On the chest's armpit surface is an about 1/2 x  
155 1/4 inch re-entry wound. The track continues into the chest  
156 cavity passing through the lungs.

157 Projectile: Free in the left chest cavity is a grey metal  
158 bullet fragment. Embedded in the chest wall is a copper-colored  
159 jacket fragment.

160 Trajectory: Assuming the arm is raised at the time of  
161 wounding, the track extends in a primarily right to left  
162 direction.

163 Perforating gunshot wound to right forearm

164 Entrance wound: On the lateral right forearm about 16-1/2  
165 inches from the tip of the longest finger and 1 inch in front of  
166 a coronal midline is a 3/16 inch, roughly round wound with  
167 1-3/16 inch rim of red-brown abrasion widest at the 11 o'clock  
168 margin.

169 Pathway: The track extends through the hemorrhagic muscle  
170 and soft tissue of the forearm.

171 Exit wound: On the anterior and medial right forearm about  
172 11-1/2 inches from the tip of the longest finger and 1 inch left  
173 of an anterior-posterior midline through the arm is a 1-1/2 x

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174 1-1/4 inch irregular-shaped wound.

175 Trajectory: The track extends right to left and slightly  
176 downward.

177 Perforating gunshot wound to right wrist

178 Entrance wound: On the back of the right wrist about 7  
179 inches from the tip of the longest finger and along an anterior-  
180 posterior midline through the arm is a 3/16 inch round wound  
181 with a 1/16 inch rim of red-tan abrasion.

182 Pathway: The track passes through the superficial tissues  
183 of the wrist.

184 Exit wound: On the outside of the back of the right wrist  
185 about 7-1/4 inches from the tip of the longest finger and 1-3/4  
186 inches right of an anterior-posterior midline through the arm is  
187 a 5/16 x 3/16 inch, irregular-shaped wound.

188 Trajectory: The track extends primarily left to right.

189 Graze-type wound to right forearm

190 On the posterior and radial right mid forearm about 10-1/2  
191 inches from the tip of the longest finger and 1 inch left of  
192 anterior-posterior midline through the arm is a roughly  
193 transversely oriented 1-1/2 x 5/6 inch, 3/8 inch deep wound with  
194 patchy up to 1/8 inch red-brown abrasion.

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195           Perforating gunshot wound to the upper right thigh

196           Entrance wound: On the upper medial right thigh about  
197   27-1/2 inches above the heels and 4 inches left of an anterior-  
198   posterior midline through the leg is a 1/8 inch, round wound  
199   with a 1/8 inch rim of red-brown abrasion.

200           Pathway: The track extends through the hemorrhagic muscle  
201   and soft tissue of the left without involving the femoral  
202   vessels or the femur.

203           Exit wound: On the back of the right thigh about 24 inches  
204   above the heels and along a posterior-anterior midline through  
205   the leg is a 1-1/2 x 3/4 inch irregular-shaped wound.

206           Trajectory: The track extends front to back, very slightly  
207   left to right, and slightly downward.

208           Graze-type wound to upper anterior right thigh

209           On the anterior upper right thigh about 30 inches above the  
210   heels and 3 inches left of anterior-posterior midline through  
211   the leg is a roughly transversely oriented 1-1/4 x 1/4 inch less  
212   than 3/16 inch slightly hemorrhagic graze-type wound.

213           Perforating wound to upper lateral right thigh

214           Entrance wound: On the right upper lateral right thigh  
215   about 31-1/2 inches above the heels, 2 inches right of an  
216   anterior-posterior midline through the leg, and 2-1/2 inches in

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217 front of a coronal midline is a  $3/8 \times 3/16$  inch oval wound with  
218 a  $1/16$  inch rim of red-brown abrasion.

219 Pathway: The track extends superficially through the  
220 slightly hemorrhagic muscle and soft tissue of the side of the  
221 thigh.

222 Exit wound: On the side of the right thigh about 30 inches  
223 above the heels and  $2-1/2$  inches behind a coronal midline is a 2  
224 x 1 inch irregular-shaped wound.

225 Trajectory: The track extends primarily front to back.

226 Perforating gunshot wound to mid lateral right thigh

227 Entrance wound: On the side of the right thigh about  $28-1/2$   
228 inches above the heels and  $1-1/2$  inches in front of a coronal  
229 midline is a  $1-1/4 \times 1/2$  inch irregular-shaped wound. The  
230 anterior edge of the wound shows a  $1/4$  inch rim of red-tan to  
231 red-brown abrasion, and the posterior edge of the wound is  
232 jagged.

233 Just below the wound is a separate  $1/8$  inch red-brown  
234 abrasion.

235 Pathway: The track extends through the hemorrhagic  
236 superficial subcutaneous tissue and muscle.

237 Exit wound: On the mid lateral right thigh about  $28-1/2$   
238 inches above the heels and 1 inch behind a coronal midline is a

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239 3/4 x 1/2 inch irregular-shaped wound.

240 Trajectory: The track extends primarily front to back.

241 Perforating gunshot wound to upper left thigh

242 Wounds: On the anterior upper left thigh about 31-1/2  
243 inches above the heels, 3-1/2 inches left of an anterior  
244 midline, and 5 inches right of an anterior-posterior midline  
245 through the leg is a 1 x 1/4 inch oval to irregular-shaped wound  
246 with 1/16 to 1/8 inch rim of tan abrasion. Above the wound is a  
247 separate 1 inch faint linear red-brown abrasion.

248 On the inside of the upper left thigh about 28-1/2 inches  
249 above the heels and 1 inch behind a coronal midline is a 5/8 x  
250 1/4 inch wound with a 1/16 to 1/8 inch rim of abrasion.

251 Pathway: The track extends through the hemorrhagic  
252 superficial fat and muscle of the thigh and does not involve the  
253 main femoral vessels.

254 Trajectory: The trajectory is uncertain.

255 Perforating gunshot wound to right thigh

256 Entrance wound: On the distal right thigh about 21-1/2  
257 inches above the heels and 1 inch left of an anterior-posterior  
258 midline through the leg is a 1/4 x 3/16 inch, round to oval  
259 wound with a 1/16 to 1/8 inch rim of red-brown abrasion widest  
260 at the 10 o'clock margin.

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261 Pathway: The track passes through the hemorrhagic muscle  
262 and soft tissue fracturing the distal femur. The popliteal vein  
263 along the track is lacerated. The artery is intact.

264 Exit wound: On the back of the distal thigh just above the  
265 popliteal fossa about 20 inches above the heels and 1 inch left  
266 of a posterior-anterior midline through the leg is a 3/8 x 1/4  
267 inch irregular-shaped wound.

268 Projectile: A small piece of copper-colored bullet jacket  
269 is recovered along the track.

270 Trajectory: The track is primarily front to back.

271 Penetrating gunshot wound to right upper chest

272 Entrance wound: On the right upper chest about 59 inches  
273 above the heels and 3 inches right of an anterior sagittal  
274 midline is a 3/8 inch, roughly round wound with a 1/8 inch rim  
275 of red-brown abrasion.

276 Pathway: The track extends through the hemorrhagic tissue  
277 of the chest wall fracturing anterior ribs and passes through  
278 the right lung and diaphragm. The track continues through the  
279 inferior vena cava and adjacent liver tissue.

280 Projectile: In the inferior vena cava below the level of  
281 the liver is found a deformed medium to large sized bullet.

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282           Trajectory: The track extends downward and very slightly  
283 front to back.

284                                   Other external injuries

285           There are scattered external blunt injuries on the body  
286 some of these may be due to secondary effects from fragmented  
287 bullets, secondary projectiles propelled by bullet strikes on  
288 nearby objects, and/or the collapse of the decedent after being  
289 shot.   None of these are associated with any significant  
290 internal injuries.

291           On the forehead are two, about 1 inch each in greatest  
292 dimension, irregular-shaped, tan abrasions. Along the right and  
293 left jaw are small, red-brown abrasions.   Several superficial  
294 1/2 to 1 inch lacerations are on the right side of the jaw and  
295 neck.   On the right parietal scalp is a 1/4 inch laceration. On  
296 the left side of the lower face and neck are rare 1/8 to 1/4  
297 inch red-brown abrasions.

298           On the top of the right shoulder are multiple, irregular-  
299 shaped, red-brown, up to 3 inch in greatest dimension abrasions.  
300 1/4 to 1-1/2 inch tan abrasions are on the lateral right  
301 shoulder above the armpit area.

302           On the back are five 1/16 to 1/2 inch irregular-shaped to  
303 slit-shaped, superficial, and slightly hemorrhagic lacerations.



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304 One of these on the left lateral mid to lower back has an about  
305 3/8 inch deep cul-de-sac into the adipose tissue.

306 Extensive linear to irregular-shaped red-tan abrasions and  
307 superficial lacerations from 1/4 to 2-1/2 inches are on the left  
308 upper arm and forearm.

309 The injuries and findings described above are not  
310 repeated.

311 EXTERNAL EXAMINATION

312 The body of well-developed, obese, medium to dark-  
313 complexion, middle-aged man is reported to be 45 years, 69  
314 inches, and 288 pounds. Rigor mortis is moderate. Livor mortis  
315 is not seen. Tattoos are on the chest and limbs including a  
316 woman on the left upper chest, a panther and "69th vill" on the  
317 right upper chest, "Nellie" on the right forearm, "ANO" and an  
318 undecipherable image on the right calf, and other undecipherable  
319 tattoos.

320 The head shows no significant scars. The hair is shaved.  
321 A short trimmed moustache and chin curtain-type beard is seen.  
322 The eyelids, sclerae, and conjunctivae show no findings except  
323 trauma. The eyes are brown. The pupils are roughly round and  
324 equal. The nose and mouth show no findings except for trauma.  
325 The teeth are in fair to good condition. An airway tube is

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326 present. The ears are intact.

327       The neck shows no significant scars. The chest shows no  
328 significant scars. A transverse over 24 inch sutured,  
329 thoracotomy incision is across the chest. A cardioversion and  
330 an ECG pad are on the torso. The genitalia are of a circumcised  
331 man.

332       The arms and forearms show only minor scars. A rubber  
333 tourniquet is on the right upper arm. The hands, fingers, and  
334 fingernails are intact. The fingernails are short. The legs and  
335 feet show only minor scars. A vascular line is in the left  
336 groin. An intraosseous catheter is in the right shin.

337       The back shows no significant scars. The anus is  
338 unremarkable.

339                               INTERNAL EXAMINATION

340       BODY WALLS AND CAVITIES: The subumbilical fat pad is over  
341 2-1/2 inches. The subcutaneous and breast tissues show no  
342 lesions except for trauma. The mediastinum is otherwise  
343 unremarkable. The pericardial sac contains about 50 mL of  
344 liquid blood. The pleural cavities each contain liquid blood.  
345 The diaphragm is otherwise unremarkable. The peritoneal cavity  
346 shows no significant adhesions. The retroperitoneal fat layer  
347 is moderately increased. The major organs are normally

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348 positioned.

349       CARDIOVASCULAR SYSTEM:     The epicardium is smooth and  
350 glistening. The coronary arteries follow a right predominant  
351 distribution and show minimal atherosclerosis. The heart is 450  
352 grams. The myocardium is red-brown, normal texture, and  
353 uniform. The right ventricular free wall does not show any  
354 significant increased fatty tissue or increased fibrous tissue.  
355 The ventricles are normal thickness. The chambers are minimally  
356 dilated. The endocardium, chordae, and papillary muscles are  
357 intact. The coronary sinus ostium is widely patent. The  
358 foramen ovale is closed. The atrioventricular and semilunar  
359 valves are normally formed, show no lesions or vegetations, and  
360 are appropriate for age. The aorta is otherwise unremarkable.  
361 The venae cavae and great vessels are otherwise unremarkable.

362       PULMONARY SYSTEM: The right and left lungs are 350 and 330  
363 grams. The lungs are red, poorly aerated, partially  
364 atelectatic, soft, and otherwise uniform. The bronchi show no  
365 significant lesions. The mucosa is red tan. The vessels show  
366 no significant thrombi or emboli.

367       HEPATOBIILIARY SYSTEM:     The liver is normal texture,  
368 otherwise uniform with a smooth glistening capsule, red-brown,  
369 and 1600 grams. The biliary tract is unremarkable. The pancreas

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370 is lobulated, normal texture, without focal lesions, and tan.

371       HEMATOPOIETIC SYSTEM:     The spleen is normal texture,  
372 uniform with a smooth capsule, dark red, and 120 grams. The  
373 thymus gland is unremarkable for age. The lymph nodes are not  
374 significantly enlarged and show no lesions. The bone marrow of  
375 the ribs and calvarium is unremarkable for age.

376       GASTROINTESTINAL SYSTEM:   The oropharynx, esophagus, and  
377 stomach show no lesions. The stomach contains no pills. The  
378 duodenum, jejunum, ileum, and large bowel show no mucosal,  
379 mural, or serosal lesions. The mesentery is intact. The  
380 appendix is present.

381       GENITOURINARY SYSTEM:   The adrenal glands are unremarkable.  
382 Each kidney is 150 grams. The renal capsule strips with slight  
383 difficulty. The cortices are normal thickness, normal texture,  
384 uniform, and red tan. The calyces and collecting systems are  
385 not dilated and show no lesions. The pyramids and papillae are  
386 intact. The ureters are patent to the bladder that contains  
387 clear yellow urine. The bladder mucosa and wall are  
388 unremarkable. The prostate gland is unremarkable on palpation.  
389 The testes are unremarkable on palpation.

390       MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM:   The muscles show no diffuse  
391 findings. The skeleton is well developed and appropriate for

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392 age.

393 Embedded just below a non-hemorrhagic, fibrous capsule on  
394 the surface of the distal posterior right femur is a deformed,  
395 dull grey metal bullet.

396 HEAD AND NERVOUS SYSTEM: The scalp and skull show no  
397 lesions except for trauma. The dura mater and leptomeninges  
398 show lesions except for trauma. The floor of the skull and  
399 dural sinuses are otherwise unremarkable. The circle of Willis  
400 shows no aneurysms and no significant atherosclerosis. The  
401 brain is about 1300 grams. The cerebral hemispheres,  
402 cerebellum, and brain stem show no medical lesions. The  
403 pituitary gland is not identified.

404 ANTERIOR NECK STRUCTURES: The anterior neck muscles show  
405 no hemorrhage. The thyroid gland is symmetrical, not enlarged,  
406 normal texture, and red brown. The parathyroid glands are not  
407 identified. The laryngeal cartilages, cricoid cartilage, and  
408 hyoid bone are intact. The tracheal, laryngeal and epiglottic  
409 mucosa shows no lesions. The mucosa is red tan. The tongue is  
410 unremarkable. The posterior pharynx is not obstructed. The  
411 prevertebral fascia is intact. The cervical vertebrae are  
412 intact.

413
