On Wednesday, May 20, 2020 at 1218 hours, Supervising Criminalist A. Keeler was notified by Newark Police Department Sergeant Ackerman of a request for the Crime Laboratory's assistance in processing the scene of an officer involved shooting. Supervising Criminalist A. Keeler assigned Sheriff's Technicians T. Overcash and H. Bates to process the scene, which was located at [REDACTED] Beutke Drive, Newark, CA. The assigned laboratory personnel arrived at 1455 hours and met with Detective Arroyo.

The Laboratory was requested to search, document the scene, and collect evidence.


Overview of Scene


Exterior


The house at [REDACTED] Beutke Drive is located [REDACTED] of Beutke Drive which runs in an east-west direction and Sycamore Street and is in a residential neighborhood in Newark with single family homes lining each side of the street. Sycamore Street runs in a north-south direction and is located on the east side of the home. The front lawn wraps around from the front to the east (Sycamore Street) side.

A deceased adult male in a face up position with his head towards the Beutke Drive residence and his feet towards Sycamore Street was located partially on the sidewalk and grass of east side of the residence. Per Detective Arroyo, the decedent had been moved prior to our arrival. His hands were palm down resting on his lower abdomen. There was apparent blood on his head, face, his right arm, and the right side of his shirt which was pulled up to reveal his chest. He had a medical device in his mouth and EKG pads on his abdomen and forearm. His blue jeans were cut up the front and laying open. Gun Shot Residue stubs were collected by Sheriff's Technician H. Bates from the decedents' hands prior to removal by the Coroner's office. A pair of sunglasses (Marker 6) were located south of decedent and one blue baseball hat (Marker 5) with a flag on the front was located west of decedent.

In the south bound lane of Sycamore Street, east of [REDACTED] Beutke Drive, a green Toyota Camry with a California license plate [REDACTED] was parked at the curb with the passenger door open. Three unmarked law enforcement vehicles; a [REDACTED] were also parked in the south bound lane. Both the front and rear driver side doors of the [REDACTED] were open and the interior red and blue lights were on. The [REDACTED] interior red and blue lights were on and both vehicles were parked at a southwest angle facing the rear of the Camry. The [REDACTED] was parked northwest in the street with the drivers' side door open, facing the front of the Camry. (Refer to diagram)

Officer Involved Shooting

One "Winchester 223 REM" cartridge case (Marker 1) was located in the center turning lane directly east of the Camry and between the [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. One *Jandd Mountaineering* black canvas bag (Marker 7) containing a garage door remote, condoms, and a blue data cable was located on the sidewalk near the Camry's rear passenger door.

A pool of apparent blood (Marker 3) and one "Winchester 45 Auto" cartridge case (Marker 2), one "Winchester 45 Auto" live round, magazine with rounds and a black "11.25 m/m Aut. Pistol M/1914" handgun (all Marker 4) were located on the grass between the east wall and the Camry. Per Detective Arroyo, the handgun was made safe and the magazine removed by Newark PD prior to our arrival.

Bullet Trajectory

An apparent bullet hole (Marker A) with no outward splintering of wood was located in the south side of the fence on the east side of the residence, an apparent bullet hole (Marker B) with outward splintering in the lower north side of the rear communal fence, and a bullet hole (Marker C) in the lower south wall of the neighboring resident at [REDACTED] Sycamore Street. (Refer to diagram) A deformed lead core of a bullet (Marker C) was recovered after documentation by T. Overcash.



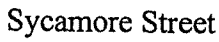

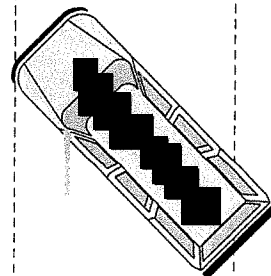
