This is a supplemental report to the Officer Involved Shooting incident which occurred at 560 N. San Jacinto Street, Hemet, California on August 16, 2020.

On Sunday, August 16, 2020, at approximately 0710 hours, I was contacted by Senior Investigator M. Moreno of the Riverside County District Attorney's Office Bureau of Investigations. Senior Investigator Moreno requested I respond to 560 N. San Jacinto Street, in the City of Hemet regarding an Officer Involved Shooting incident. The deceased suspect in this case was later identified as Ysidro Espinoza.

At approximately 0940 hours, I arrived at the command post. The command post was in the parking lot in the North West corner of N. San Jacinto Street and Oakland Avenue in the city of Hemet. I was tasked as the scene investigator and I was assisted by Investigator D. Klinzing and Property/Evidence Technician A. Murphy of the Hemet Police Department.

I attended the incident briefing provided by Detective Willison of the Hemet Police Department. During the incident briefing I learned several Hemet Police Department Officers were involved in a pursuit of a Homicide Suspect, Ysidro Espinoza. At the termination of the vehicle pursuit an Officer Involved Shooting occurred and two Officers from the Hemet Police Department discharged their duty weapons. Espinoza also suffered a self-inflicted gunshot wound to his head and he laid deceased in the roadway.

I, along with Sr. Investigator M. Moreno, Sr. Investigator F. Villalobos, Hemet PD Investigator D. Klinzing and Hemet Evidence/Property Technician A. Murphy did a scene walk through. Investigator D. Klinzing and I identified relevant evidence that was later photographed, measured, collected and booked into evidence at the Hemet Police Department by Evidence/Property Technician A. Murphy.

Investigator D. Klinzing also said he learned there were several adult males in an area North of 560 N. San Jacinto Street that were congregating under a large tree. They were no longer in the area when we did our crime scene walkthrough. There were several bicycles and a large amount of trash that gave the appearance several people were temporarily staying in the area. Refer to my additional supplemental report regarding my attempted interviews of subjects I located in the area near the bicycles on Monday August 17, 2020.
